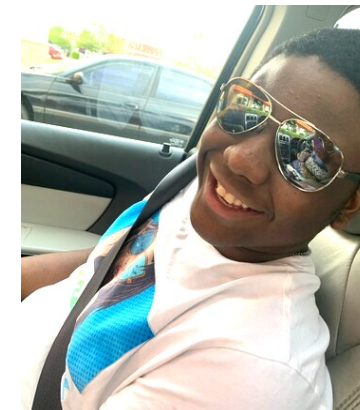
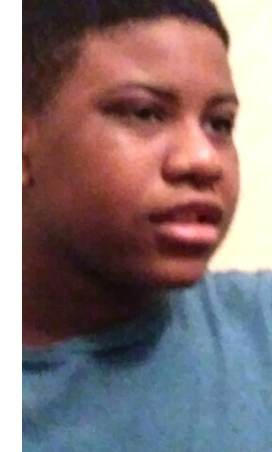
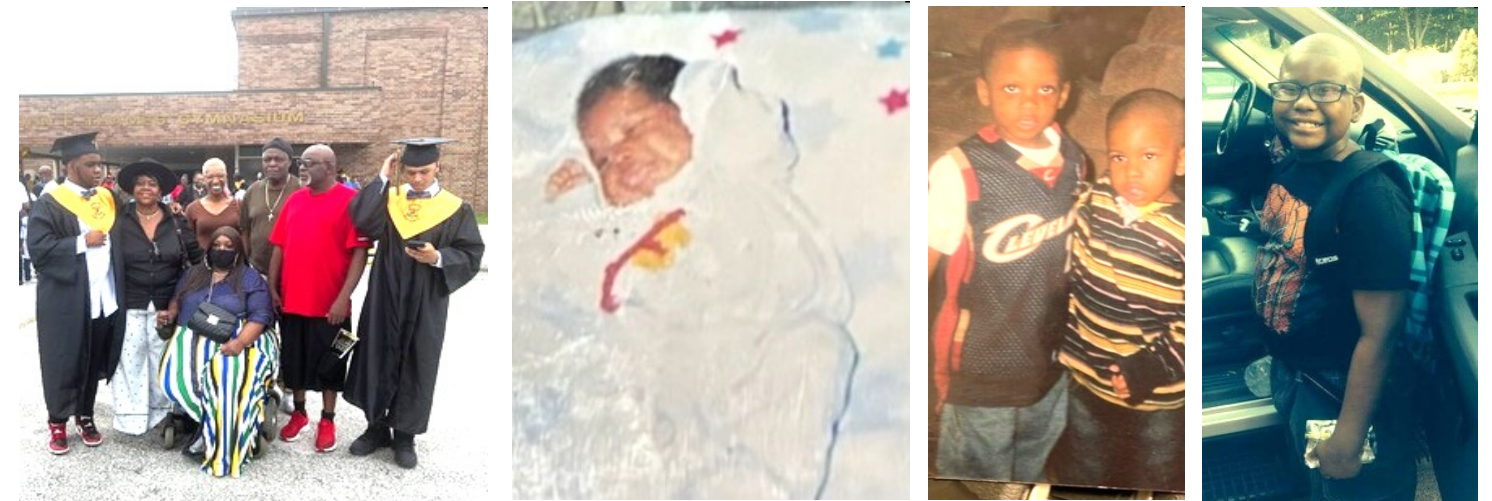
Life Reflections
