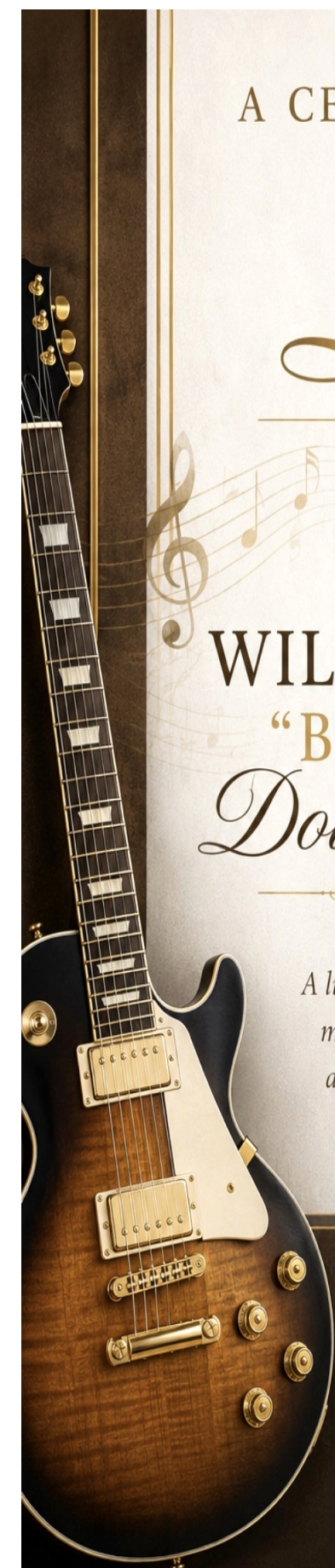

**William O. Doughty**, known to most as “**Bill**”, was born to the late William Doughty and Victoria B. Doughty on October 7, 1943, in Summerton, South Carolina.

### A Time to Recount

“**Bill**” attended Scotts Branch High School in Summerton, South Carolina where he excelled in art, music and basketball. While still a student at Scotts Branch High School, “**Bill**” served as a school bus driver, which attests to the level of trust the school district had in him, even at such a young age. “**Bill**” was a favorite of both the faculty and fellow students. Upon high school graduation in 1963, “**Bill**” relocated to Bronx, New York to live with his older sisters and brothers. In 1965, “**Bill**” was inducted into military service at Fort Jackson, Columbia, South Carolina. After military service, “**Bill**” returned home to Summerton, South Carolina to look after his aging parents and oversee the family farming operations.

“**Bill**” was preceded in death by his two sisters, Lillie M. Madison of Summerton, South Carolina; Roxie Allen of Atlanta, Georgia.; two brothers, John W. Doughty of Summerton, South Carolina and Roosevelt Doughty of Bronx, New York.

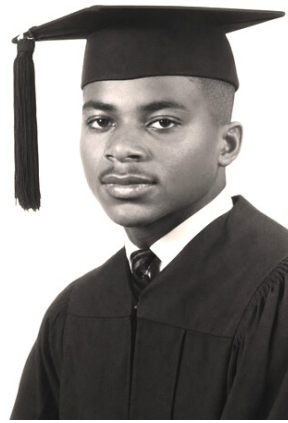
