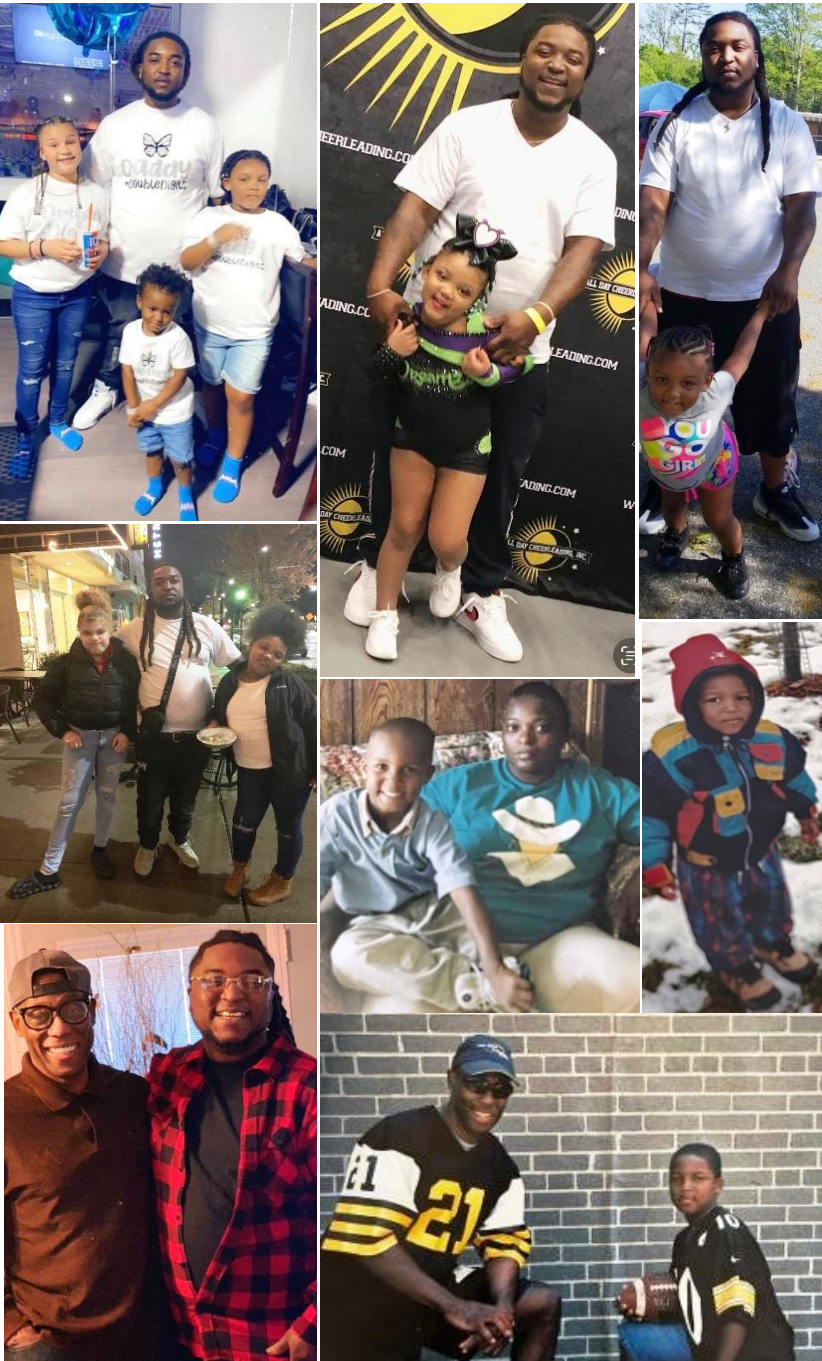
OBITUARY

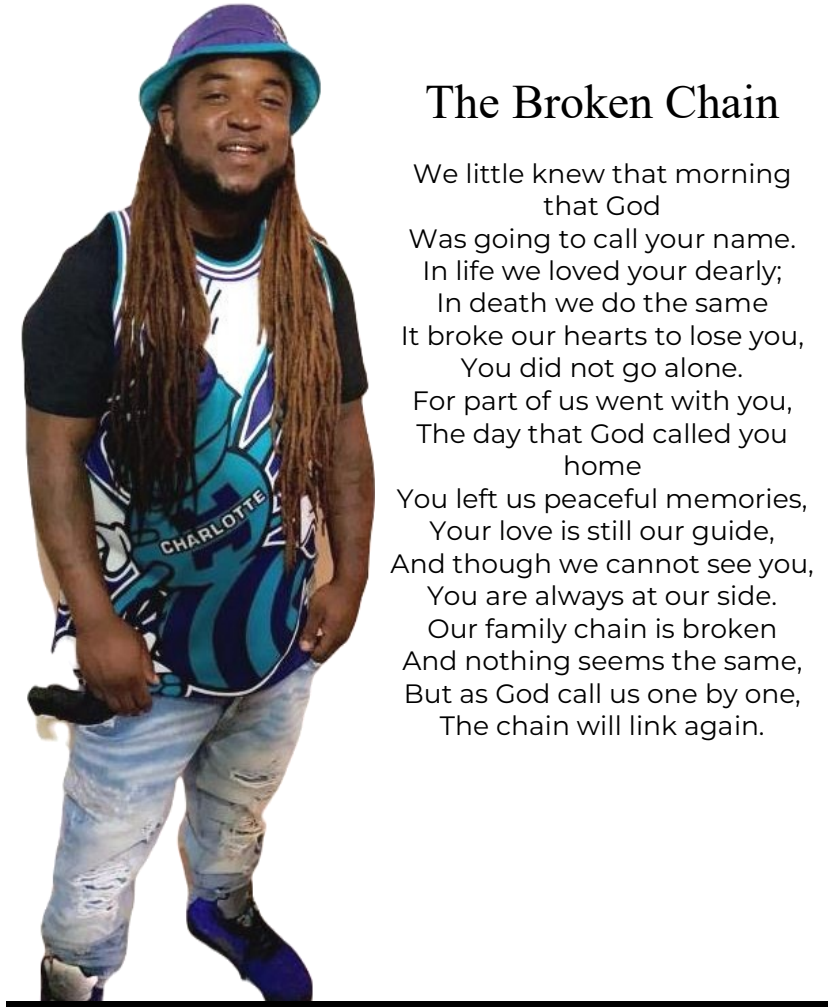
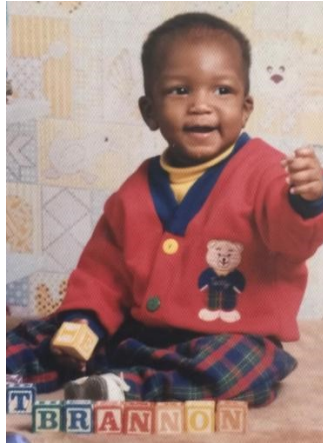
