

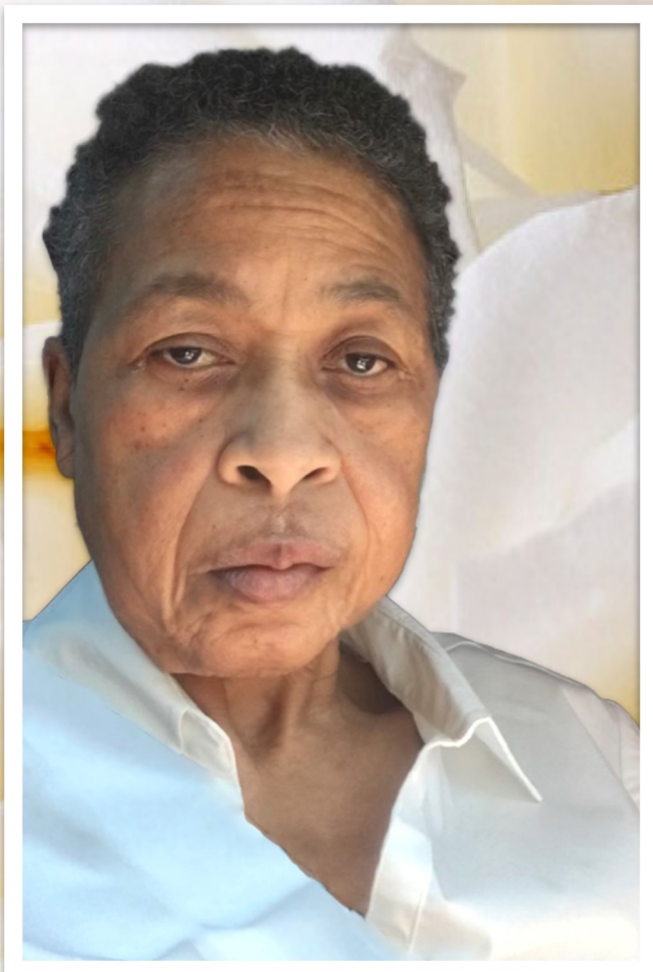


When I'm Gone
