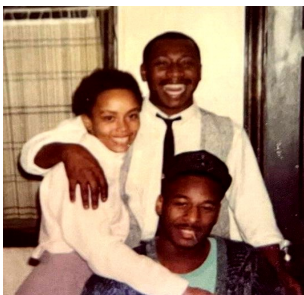
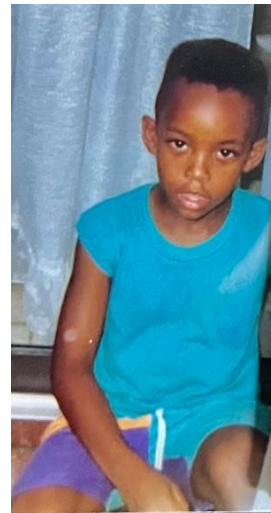
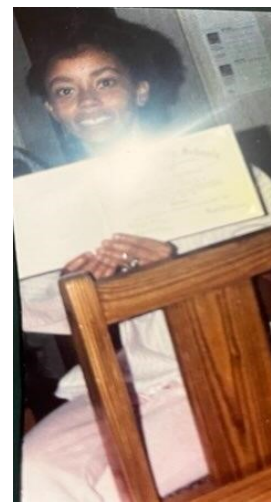
Cheryl Denise Meadows Bradley
