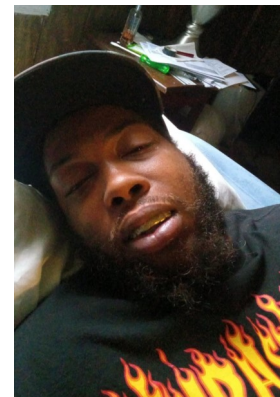
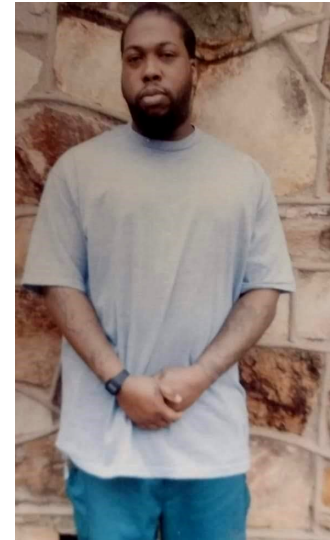
OBITUARY
