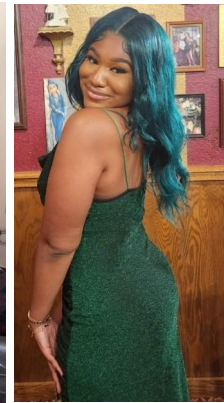
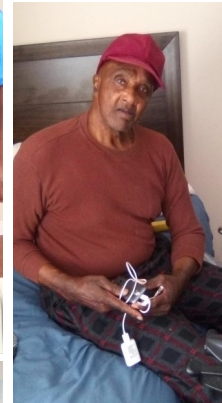
Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers: Marshall Warren and
