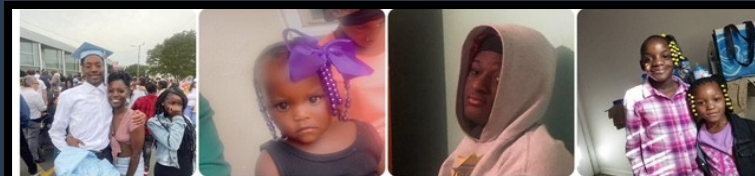
October 12, 2001 – September 20, 2024
