



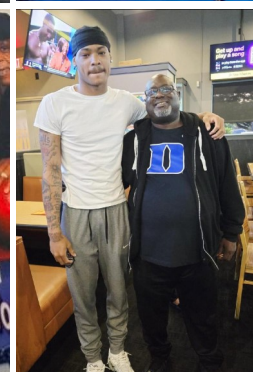
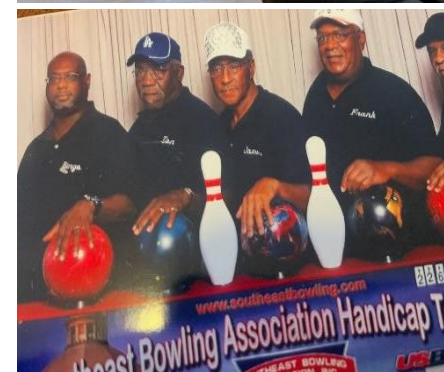
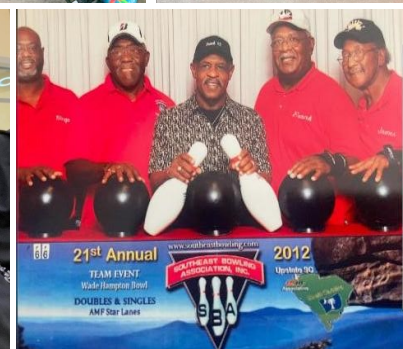
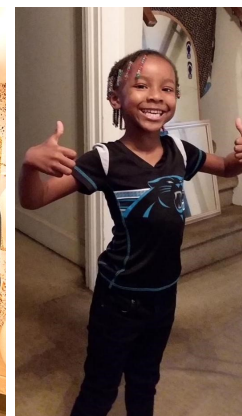
## Obituary
