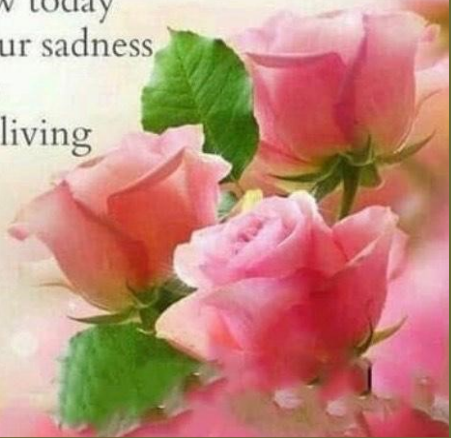


## Her Journey's Just Begun

# Life Reflections

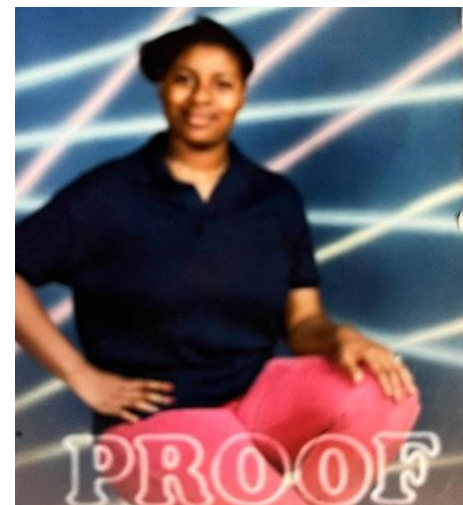
