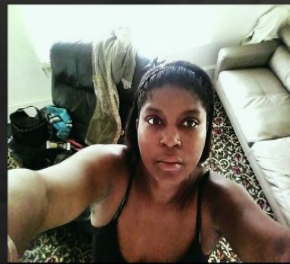
# The Life and Times Of Tomecka
