*Until we meet Again*

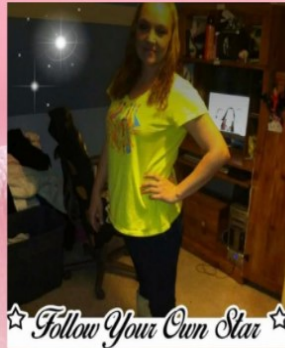
*A light from my life has gone

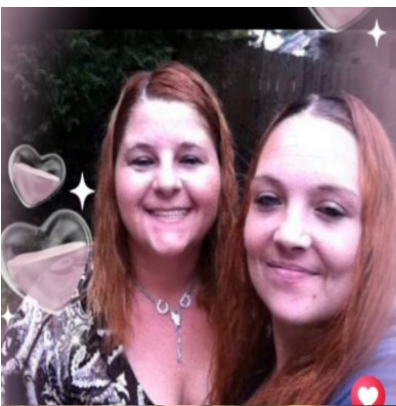
# Life Reflections
