Audrey Lovan Robinson was a native of Gastonia, North Carolina and the Highland Hills Community. Miss Audrey Robinson entered eternal rest on June 12, 2026 at the Gastonia Health and Rehabilitation Nursing Home. She was born on January 14, 1922, to the late Jefferson and Essie Dunlap Robinson. Miss Audrey Robinson lived to be 104 years of age.
