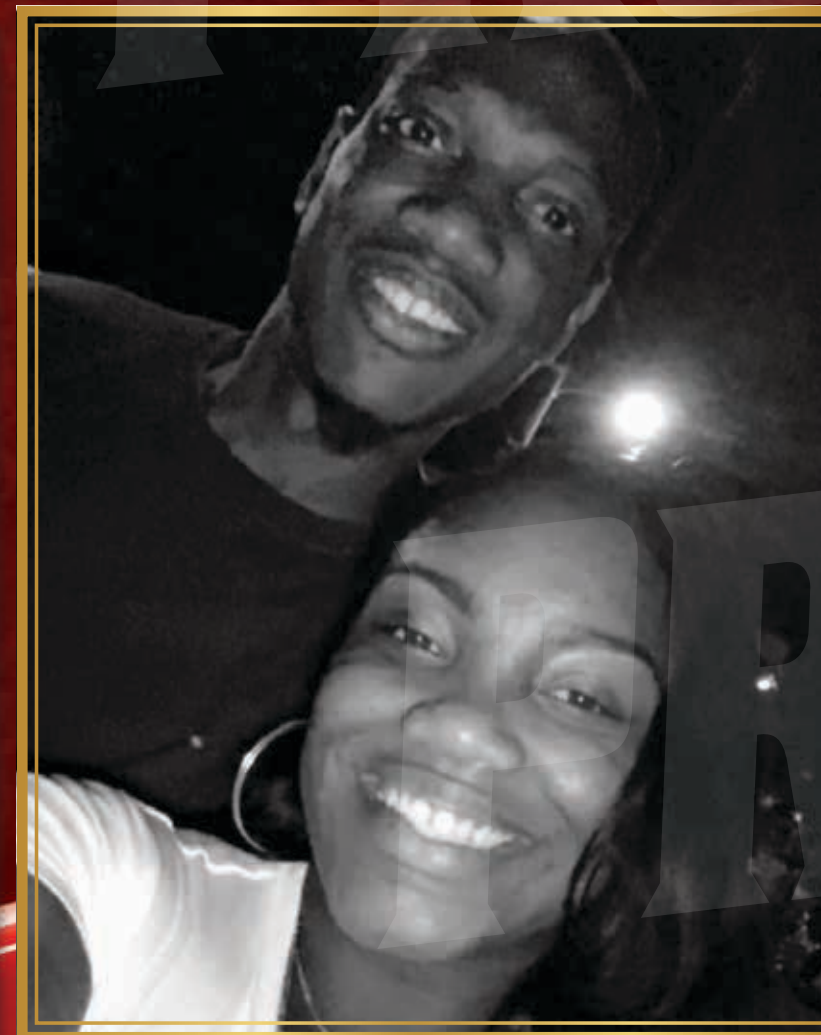

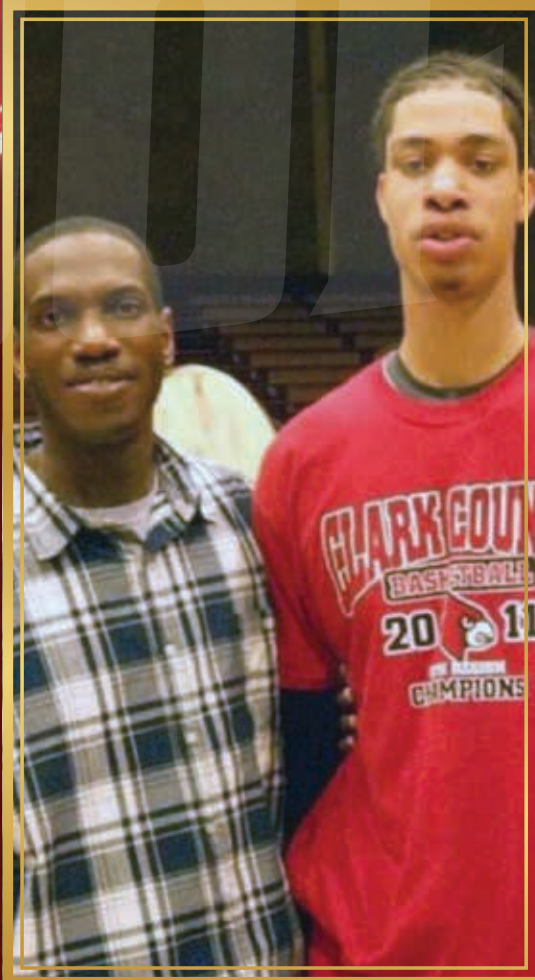

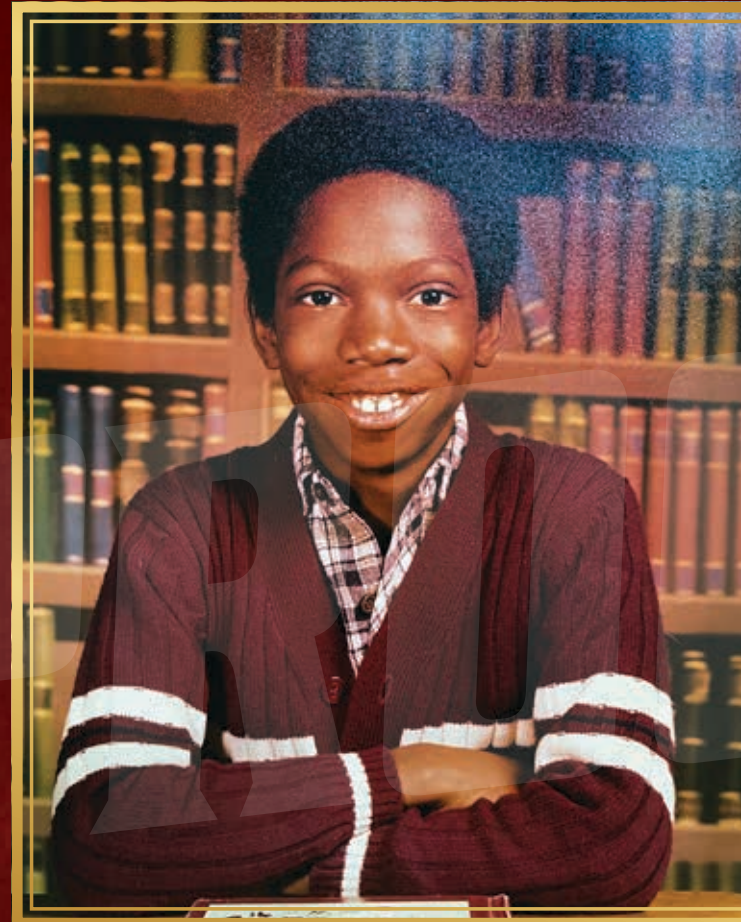
Obituary
