Obituary of Lady Lucy B. Cothran

On August 20th, 1941, a special, beautiful jewel - Lady Lucy B. Cothran was born in the city of Unadilla, GA. She was the youngest daughter of the late Grant Benjamin, Sr. and the late Rosa (Gilbert) Benjamin. Lady Lucy Benjamin Cothran began her primary education in Oviedo, FL; next she obtained her secondary education in Atlanta, where she graduated from Booker T. Washington High School, with honors. She also attended nursing school.

She learned about Jesus and was saved at an early age. As a young adult, Lady Lucy B. Cothran received the Holy Ghost and was baptized in Jesus' name at Greater Christ Temple Apostolic Church, under the leadership of Bishop Willie B Mitchell in Atlanta GA.

Lady Lucy B. Cothran's God given talents afforded her the opportunity to obtain positions at several non-profit organizations across Atlanta. She worked at Grady Memorial Hospital, where she excelled in helping patients. She also worked at the Atlanta Police Department where she was able to help many people resolve their issues. On Nov. 19, 1993, Lucy B. Cobb married Pastor Henry Cothran of Christ Temple Apostolic Faith Church of Cedartown, GA. She became the Apple of his eye and his sweet Georgia Peach. From that point on, she became Lady Lucy Cothran and Mother of the Church. Lady Lucy B. Cothran taught Sunday school, she spearheaded the Junior choir, and she coordinated many programs at the church. A woman of prayer and praise, Mrs. Lucy B. Cothran was a faithful member of a midweek Intercessory Group, which was comprised of members from ten different churches. Every year, her church family at Christ Temple Apostolic Faith Church celebrated her for the Lady Day Celebration.

Lady Lucy B. Cothran was very thoughtful, loving and she imparted a lot of wisdom. Lady Lucy B. Cothran had a sweet spirit, she was a kind lady, who told people about Jesus, and she gave great advice and helpful tips. Lady Lucy B. Cothran departed this life on Tuesday afternoon, November 12th, 2024; throughout her lifespan, she touched many lives during her 83 years.




