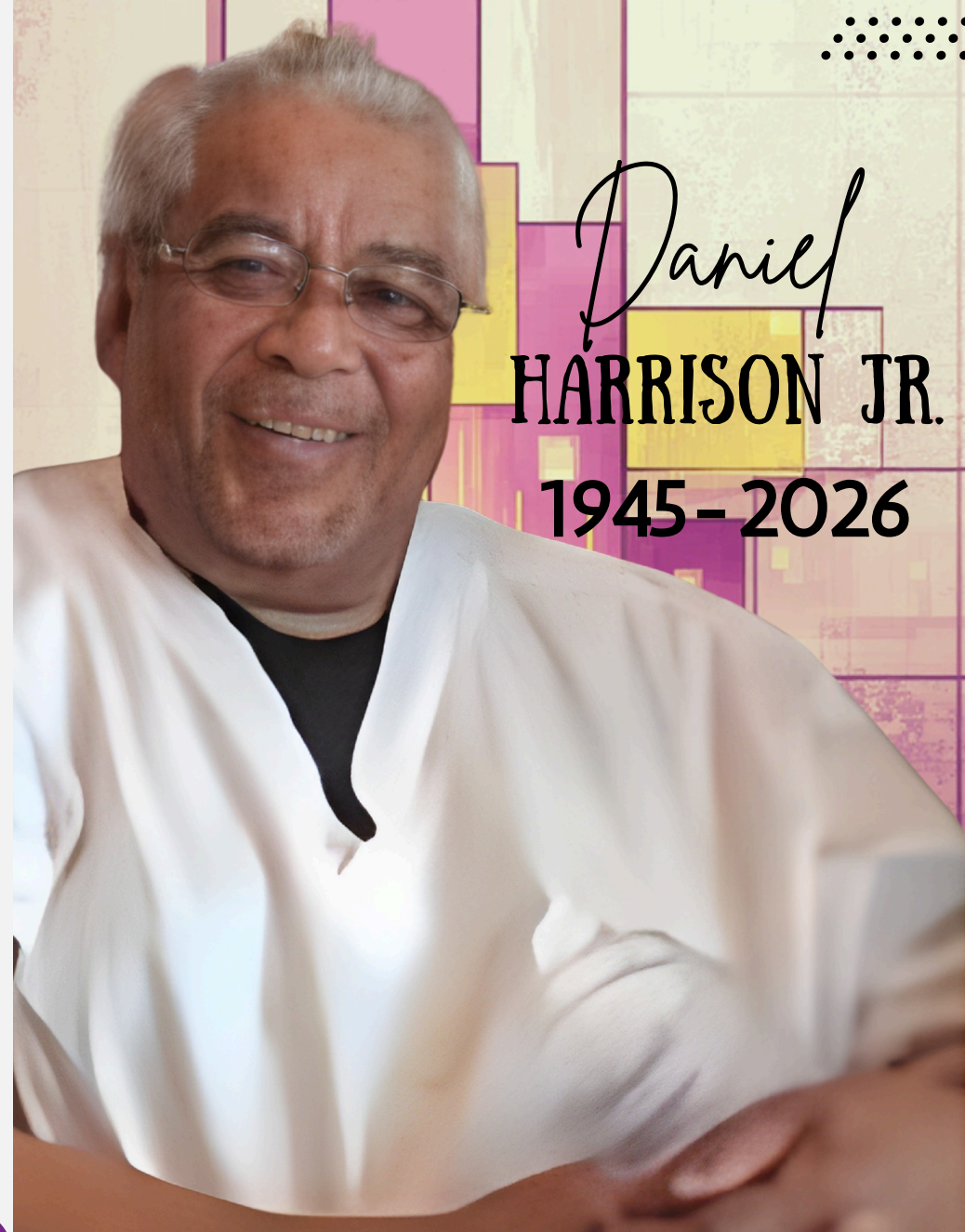


Dan never met a stranger,
