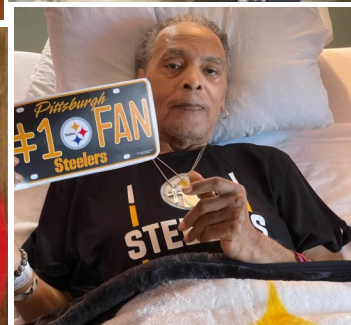
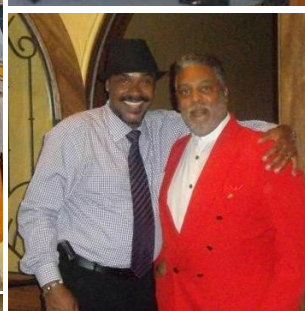




A Letter From Heaven
