



Jeffrey Beamon, 63, of Gastonia, NC, passed away on March 11, 2024, in Charlotte, NC. He was born on January 13, 1961, in Rose Hill, NC.

Jeff was a faithful and God-fearing man who lived by strong principles and found joy in Christ. He was a lifelong Aggie and a staunch supporter of NC A&T football. He cherished spending time with friends and was deeply committed to his work and spreading knowledge to better foster Christian community.

Jeff worked as a Lean Process Improvement and Division Manager at Copeland Corporation, Lean Transformation Specialist and Coach at North Carolina State University, and Sr Lean Transformation Coach at Moses Cone Health System.
