

Katrina Mary Costner, 70, affectionately called "Trina Mary", beloved mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, confidant and companion was born December 25, 1953 in Gastonia, North Carolina. She was number six of twelve children born to the late Albert Eugene "Jigger Red" Costner, Sr. and Louise Virginia Lockett Costner. She transitioned to her heavenly home Friday, October 11th, 2024, at Novant Health formerly Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte, North Carolina surrounded by her children and family.

While growing up "Trina Mary" was an attendant of Tabernacle Baptist Church in Gastonia, North Carolina with her mother. She some time visited Greater Mount Zion Baptist Church (presently Mt. Zion Restoration Church), Gastonia, North Carolina. She was a graduate of Hunter Huss High School, Gastonia NC "Class of 1972". After moving to Charlotte, North Carolina she started attending and joined Friendship Baptist Church in Charlotte, North Carolina and remained a member until her passing.

Katrina grew up in a large family filled with a host of siblings, cousins, and friends who she thought of as family. The well-known legacy of the Costner family in the community of Gastonia would be one respected for being close knit and filled with love and laughter. She later moved to Charlotte where she built her lineage. She attended Central Piedmont in Charlotte where she earned and received an Associate's Degree in Computer Programming. She was then a top hire for a prestigious computer company, EDS Electronic Data Systems (now HP Hewlett-Packard) where she retired after twenty-one years of success and leadership service.

To know Katrina is to know her love for music, entertainment, and singing. Throughout Gastonia many would know Katrina as the lead female vocalist for The Reality Band; this warranted her with the opportunity to be around the likes of Quincy Jones, Gene Friday (Organist/Pianist of Jimi Hendrix), and be considered for the original casting of The Color Purple 1985. Along with these accomplishments she was asked to fly to New York to audition as a background singer for the legendary Jean Carn. Her voice would initially be used under the direction of Tony McNeill a part of the Ladies and Mass choir for years.

Beside her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Vincent Clay Costner; nephew, Jordan Costner and great niece, Jaelyne Amarie Witherspoon.

Katrina memories will live on and always be cherished by her two loving children, Veryl Costner (Vania) of Winston-Salem, NC and Ariana Costner of Charlotte, NC; siblings, Eunice C. 


