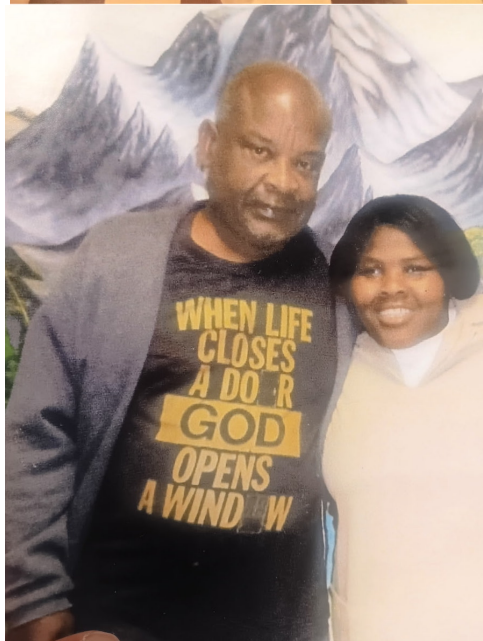
Rebecca was born on March 7, 1974 to Ms. Annie R. Spencer and Mr. Robert McLendon who both preceded her in death.
