LIFE STORY

CHARLES WINTERS, beloved husband of Esther Winters died peacefully in his home on July 8, 2023, in Augusta, Georgia surrounded by family at his bedside.



Charles was born February 4, 1947, in Dunleith, Mississippi. He attended Soldan High School in St. Louis Missouri before enlisting into the United States Army in 1968, at the age of 21.

Charles was no stranger to achievements. During his service he was awarded: two commendation awards, three achievement medals, ranging from his leadership training

and amazing coordination over a battalion, and a recruiting badge with one gold star.
