

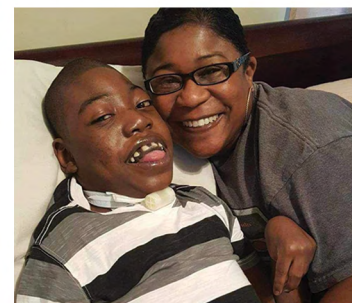
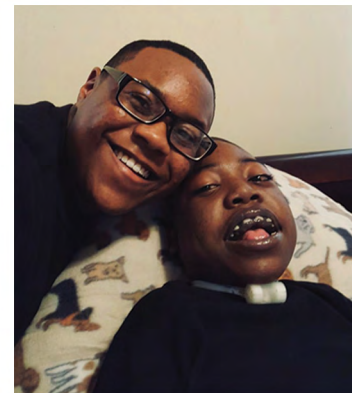
OBITUARY
