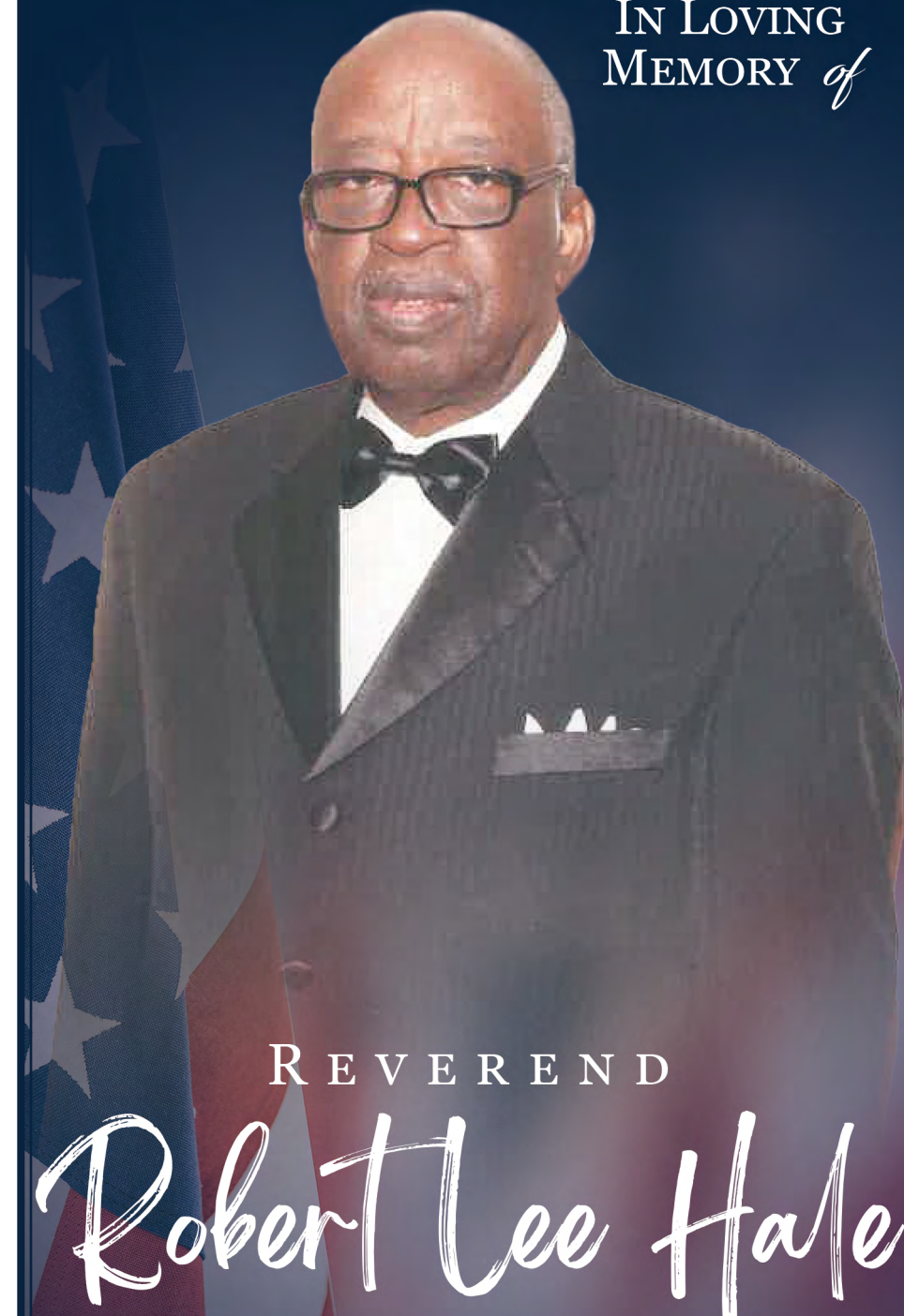

The Obituary

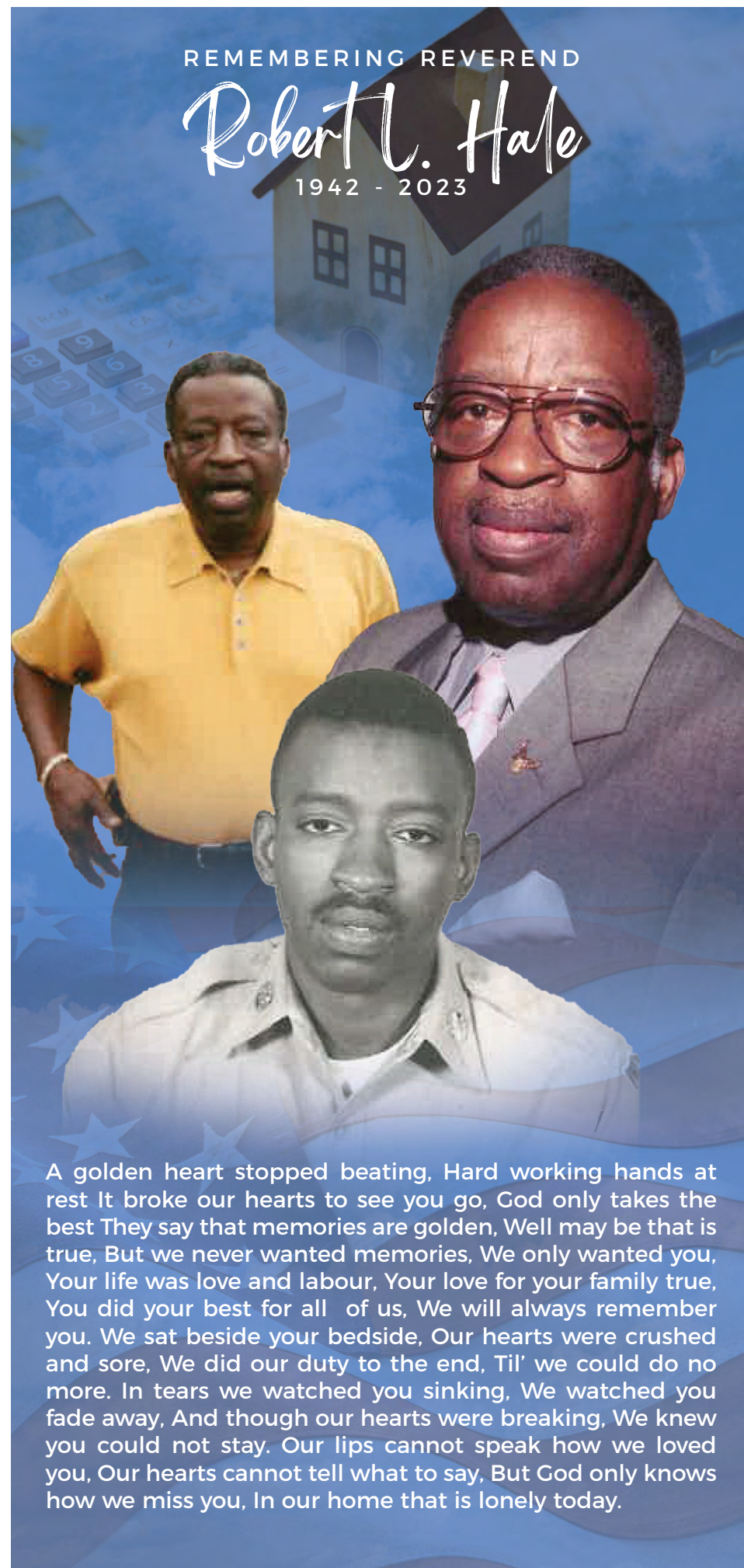
