And we will meet again.*

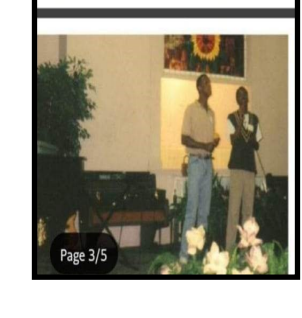
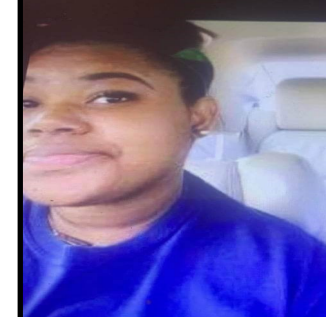
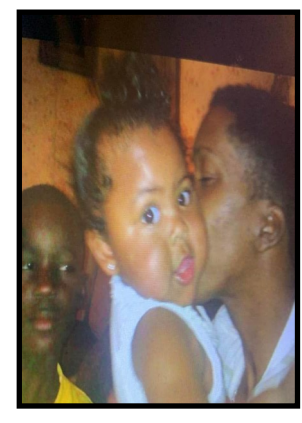
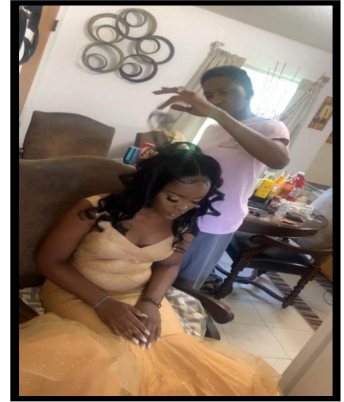
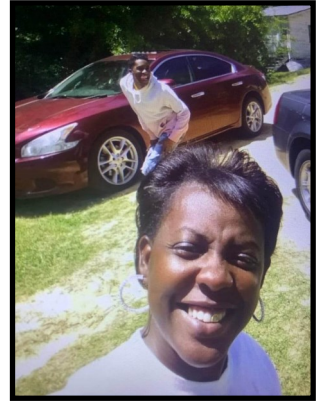
