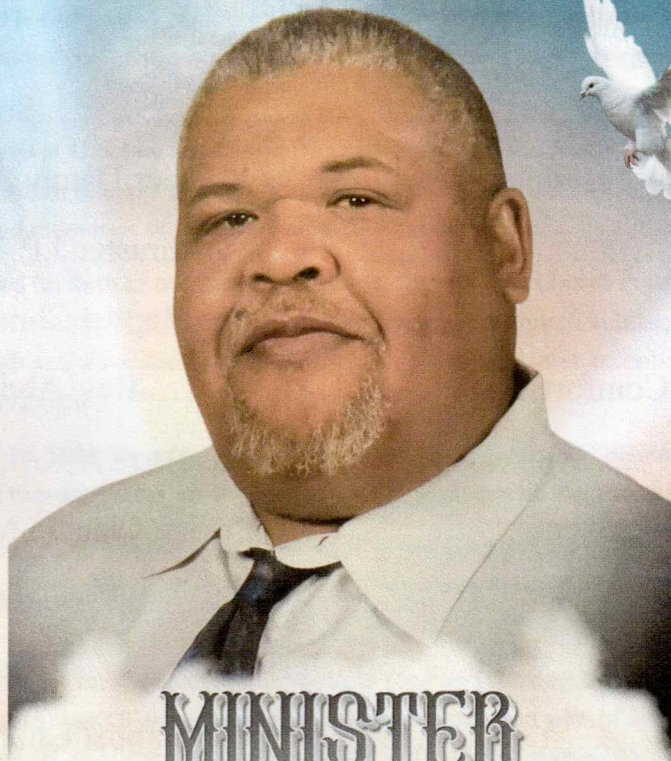

Bobby received his education from the Thomastown Attendance Center in Carthage, MS. and East Central community College in Decatur, MS. where he received his degree as a licensed electrician.

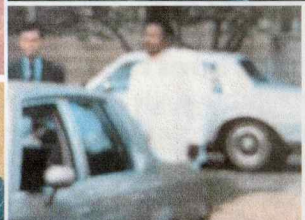

MY DEAR HUSBAND

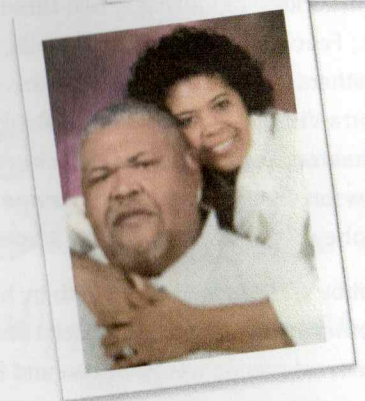
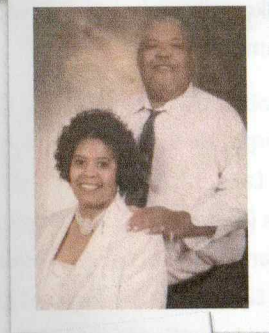
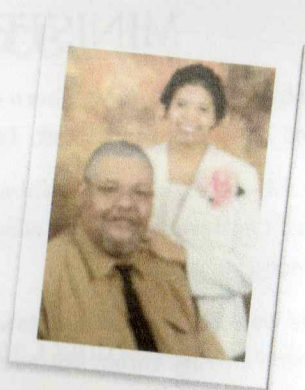
It's hard to believe you're no longer here.
