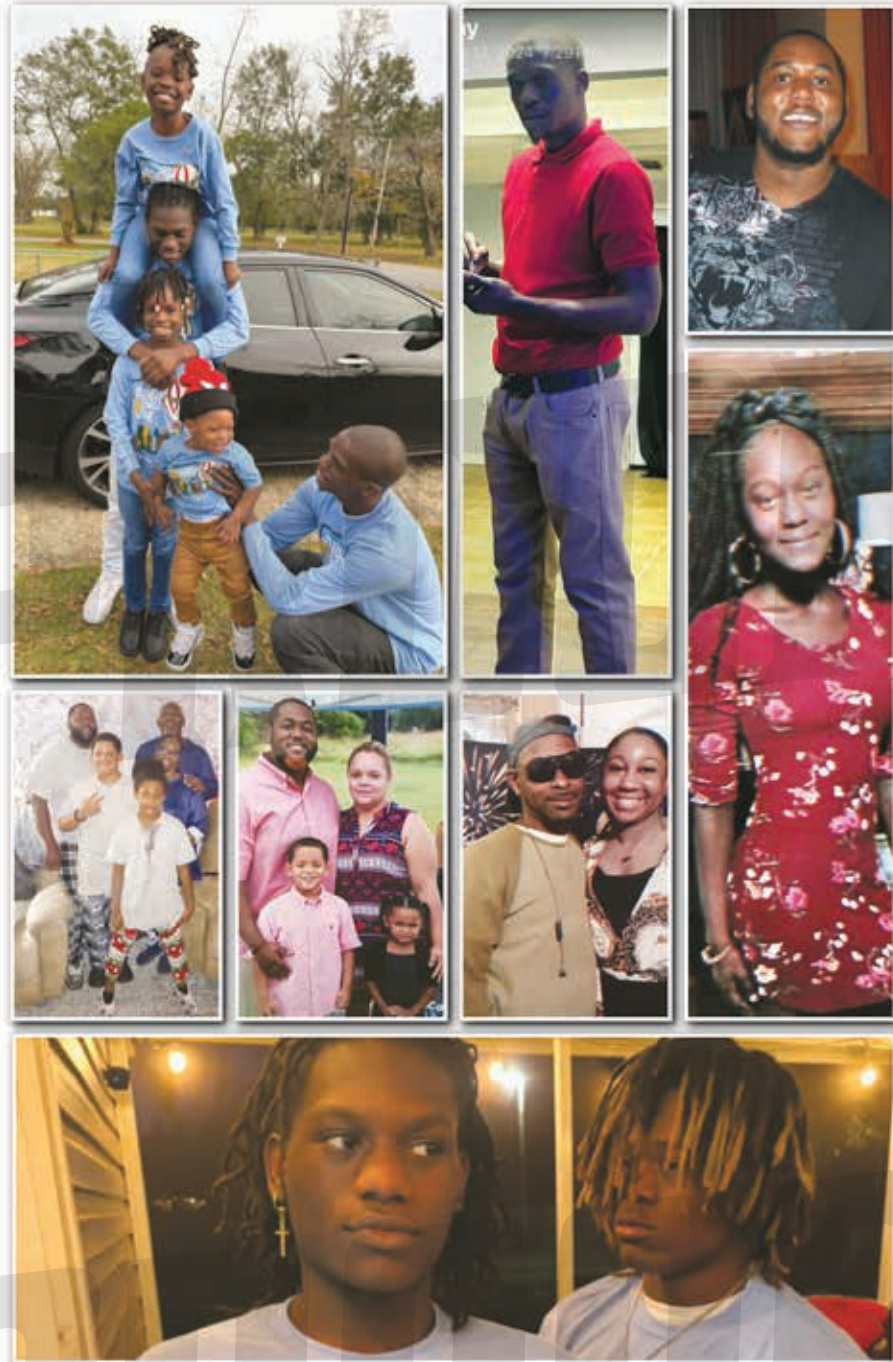

Mango "Ronnie" Lane was born to the late Horace Lane, Jr., and Lois Mills Lane.

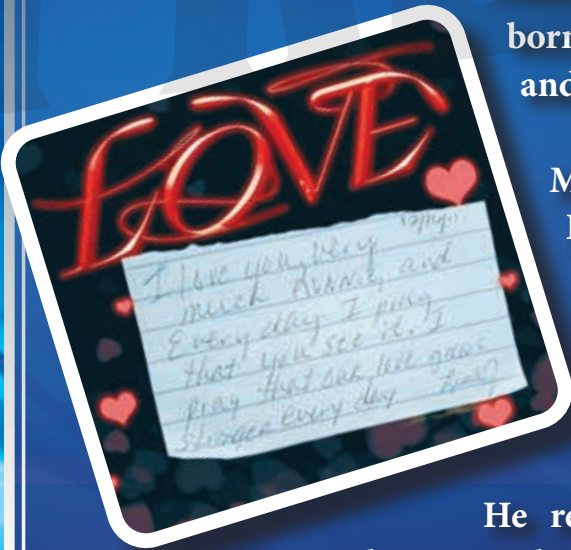
Mango was educated in the Dougherty County school system. He was joined in holy matrimony to Donna Lisa Jackson on December 16, 2015.

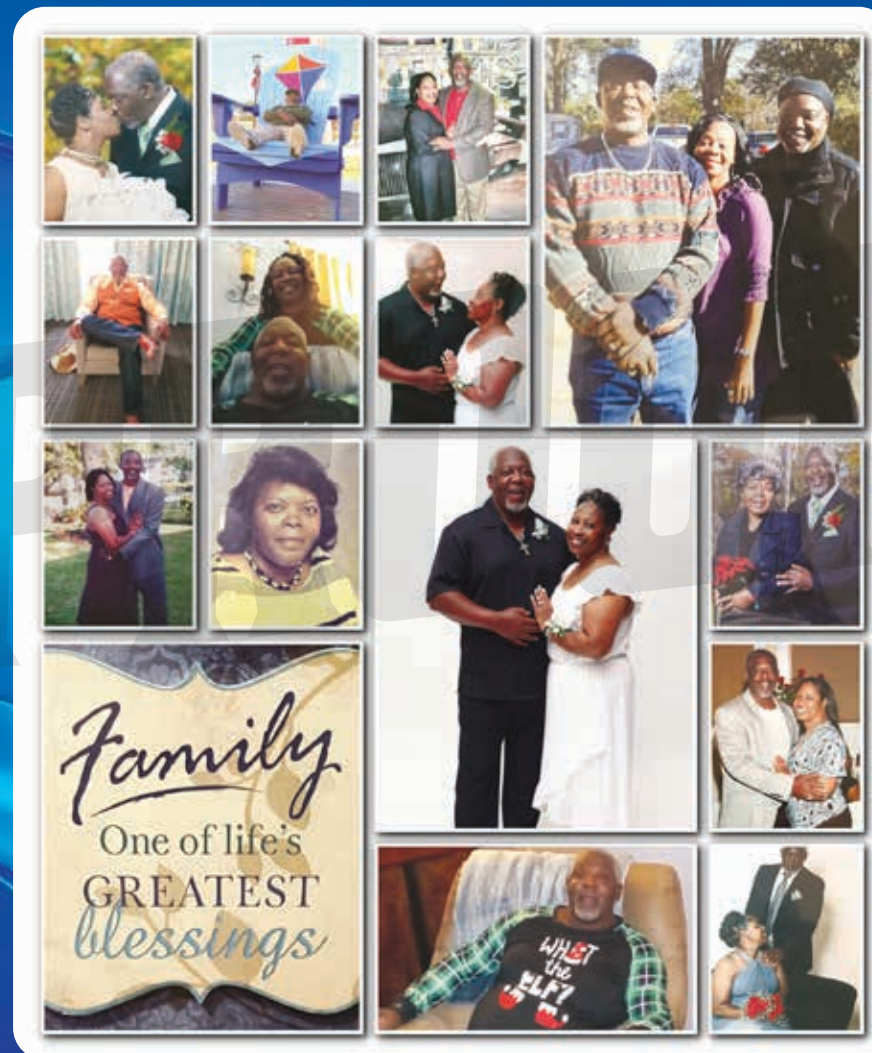
