Louise Shaw was born on March 22, 1954, in Leesburg, Georgia, to the late Mr. Harrison George and Mrs. Leila M. George.

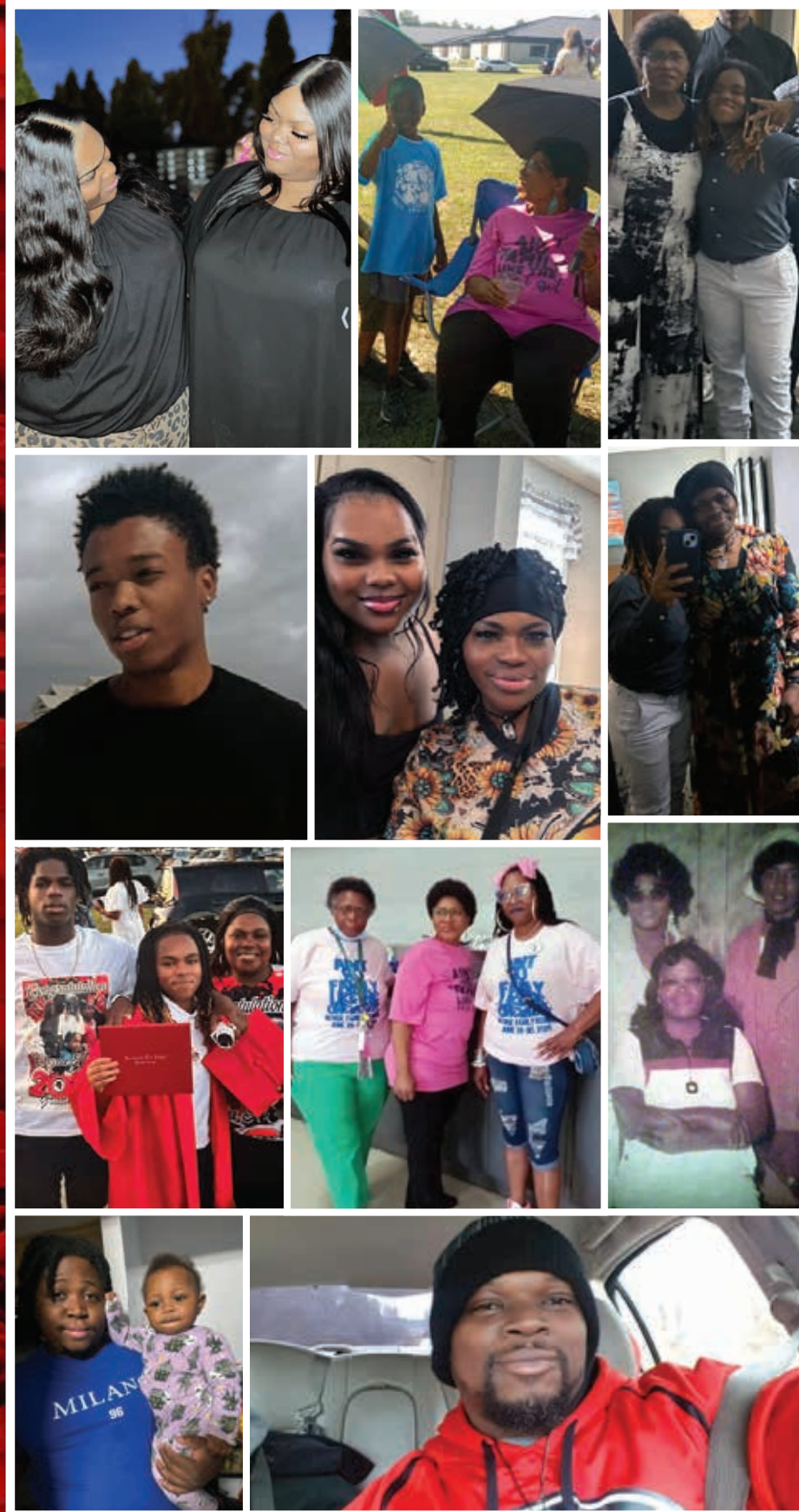
