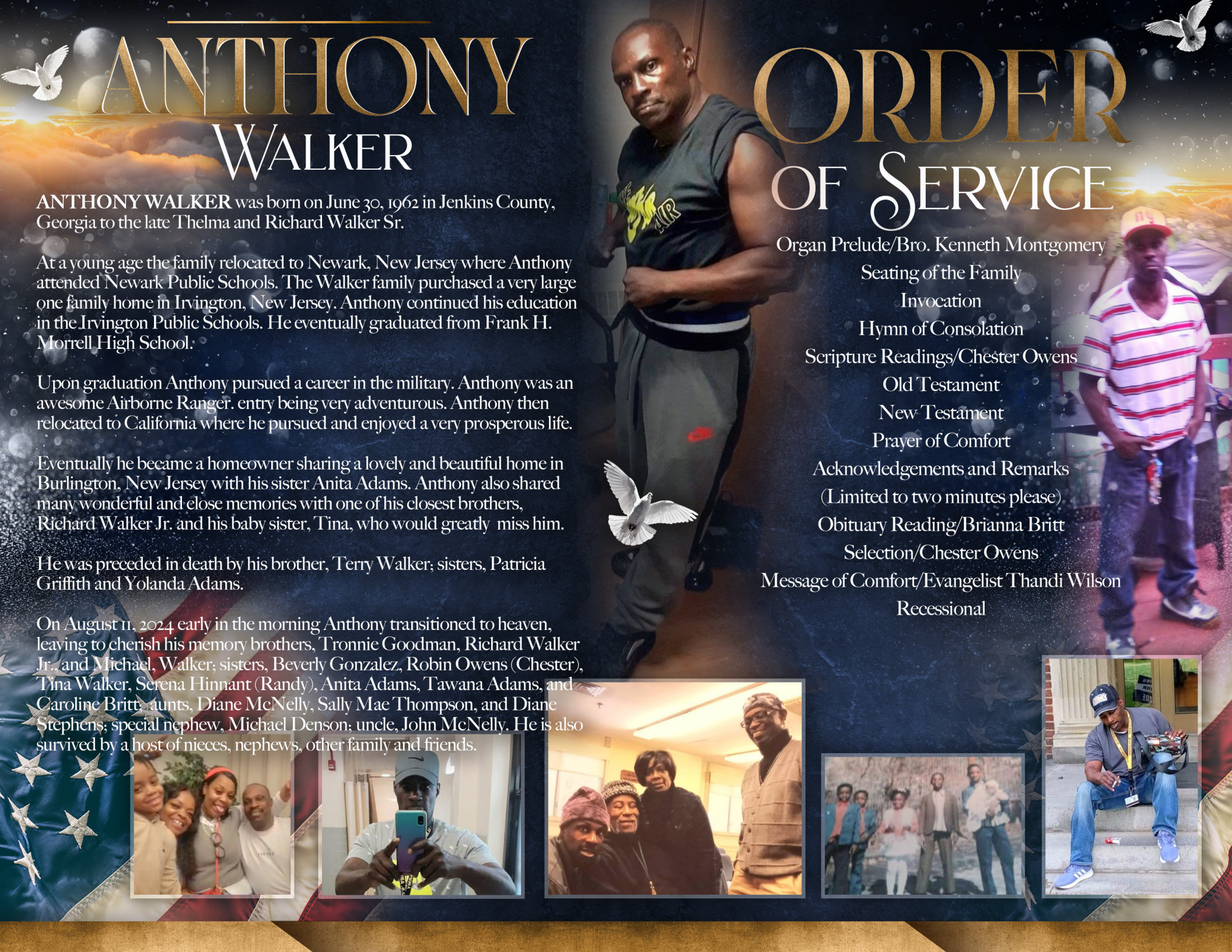

**ANTHONY WALKER** was born on June 30, 1962 in Jenkins County, Georgia to the late Thelma and Richard Walker Sr.

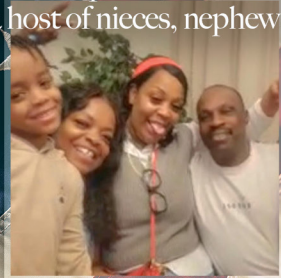
