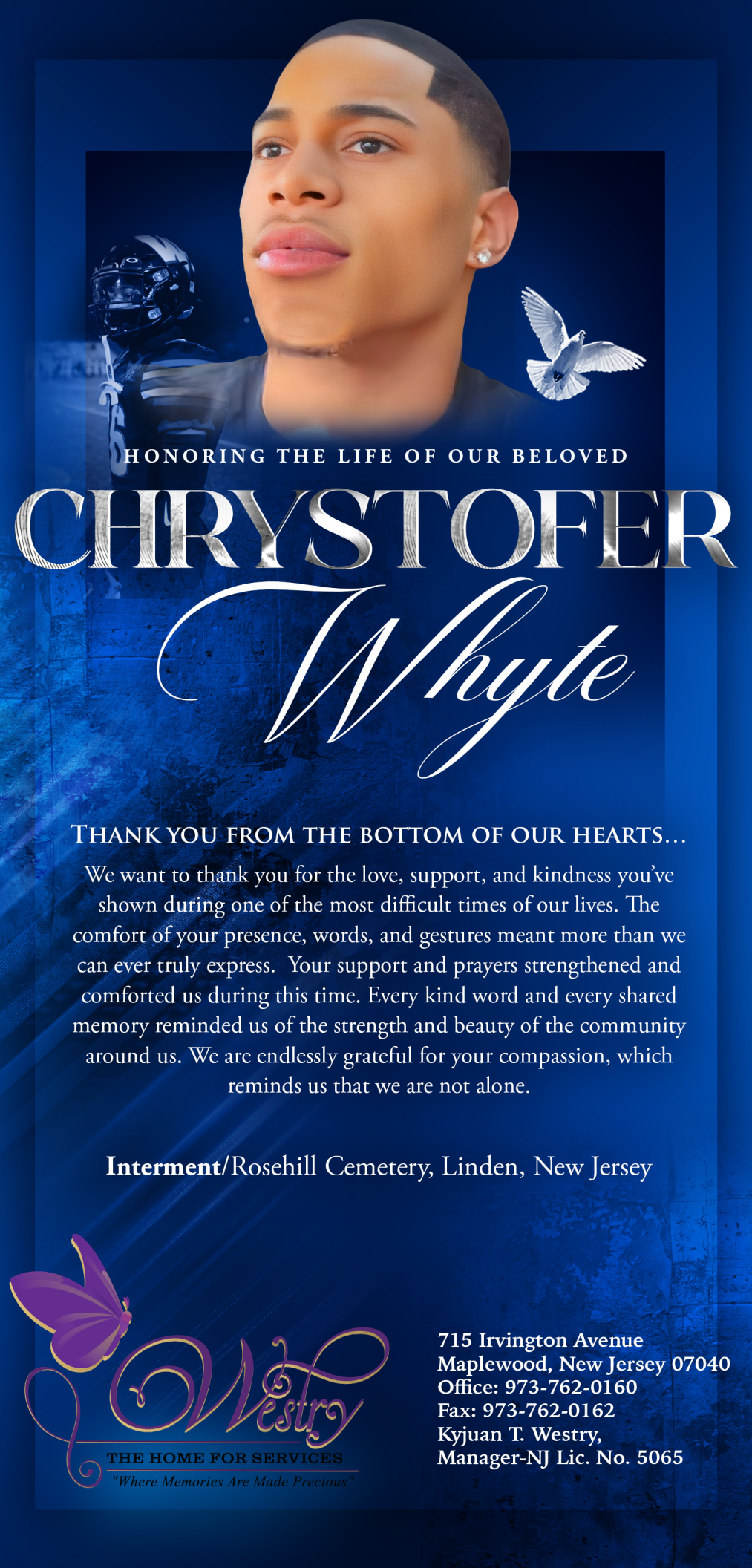


THE MASTER CALLED

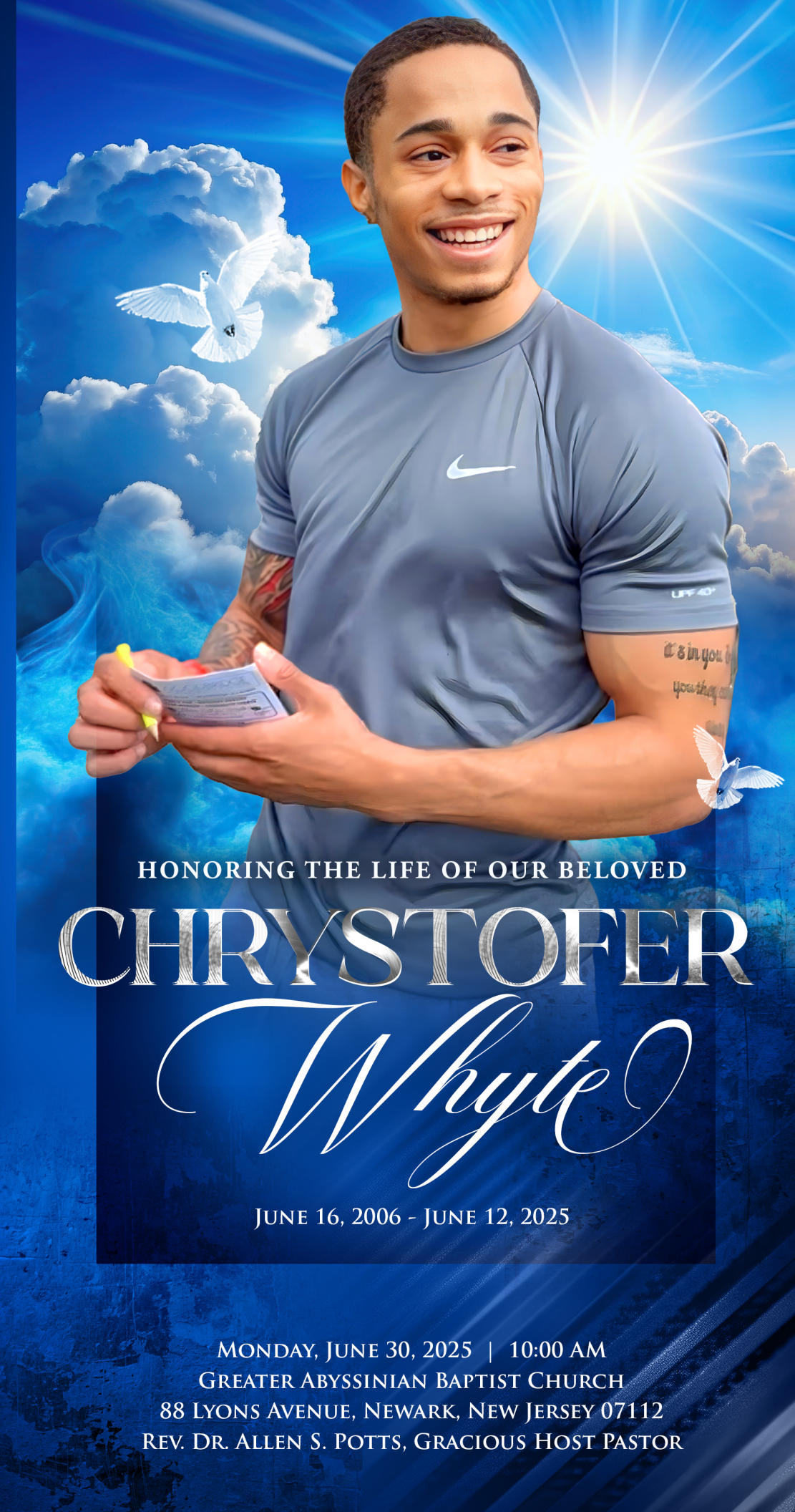

Born on June 16, 2006, in Livingston, New Jersey, Chrystofer A. Whyte was the beloved son of Joyetia Jefferys and Rodolfo Whyte. Tragically, Chrys departed this life just four days shy of his 19th birthday, on June 12, 2025.

Affectionately known as “Chrys” by his family and friends, he was a vibrant force of energy and joy from the very beginning. As a toddler, his playful curiosity was unmatched, often found hiding in cabinets or climbing wherever his imagination took him. His love for the outdoors blossomed early and would remain a defining part of his life. Chrys grew into a gifted student and athlete, even receiving special congressional recognition for his achievements.

A proud 2024 graduate of Woodbridge High School, Chrys was a dedicated member of the wrestling team for two years. It was through this sport that he cultivated a passion for fitness, healthy living, and weightlifting, transforming his body and mindset while inspiring others around him.

Beyond athletics and academics, Chrys’s magnetic personality and fearless creativity led him to become a rising star on social media. Under the TikTok handle @hi.imchrys, he amassed over 103,000 followers and more than 7.8 million likes. Whether he was dancing, hiking, skiing, or effortlessly flipping into the air, Chrys radiated confidence, humor, and joy. He wasn’t just chasing followers—he was building community, spreading laughter, and encouraging others to live boldly.

Chrys embraced life fully. He was confident, strong in both mind and body, and carried a hopeful spirit that touched everyone he encountered. In one of his final posts, he said, “I don’t know man, I’ve just got this crazy confidence that everything will work out in the end.” And that was Chrys—faithful, fearless, and full of life.

Chrystofer leaves behind a loving family to carry his memory: his parents Joyetia Jefferys and Rodolfo Whyte (Latoya); siblings Sean Jefferys, Tiffiney Whyte, Adrienne Foster, Amina Whyte, Brandon Edwards, Dymond, Nasir, Hanaa, Fuquhn Whyte, Alivia Civil, and Farrah Whyte; grandmothers Joy Renee Jefferys and Cecilia Gilkes; along with a host of devoted aunts, uncles, cousins, friends, and fans.

Though his time with us was far too short, Chrys’s light will forever shine through the countless lives he touched. His smile, his energy, and his belief that “everything will work out” live on in all of us.
