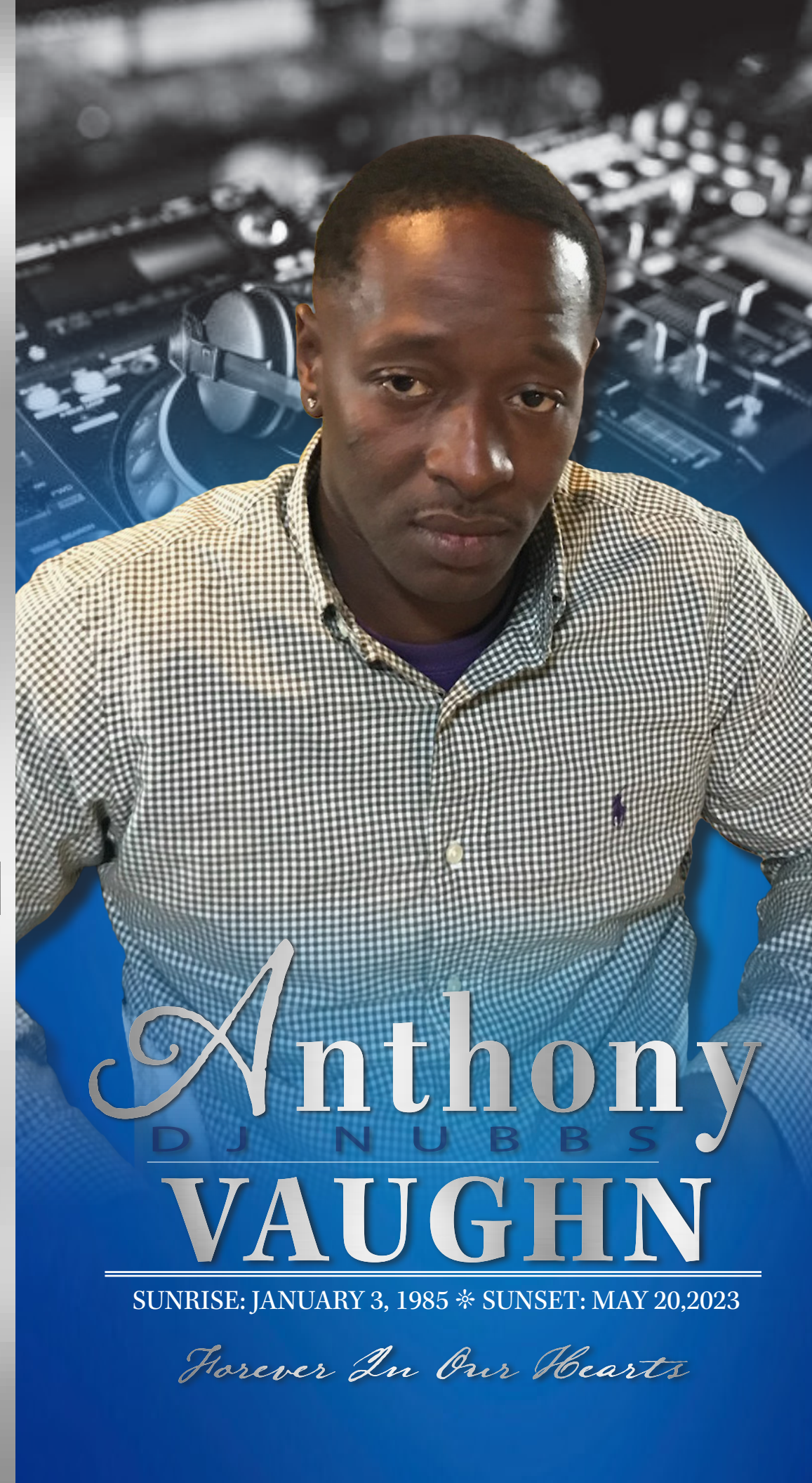

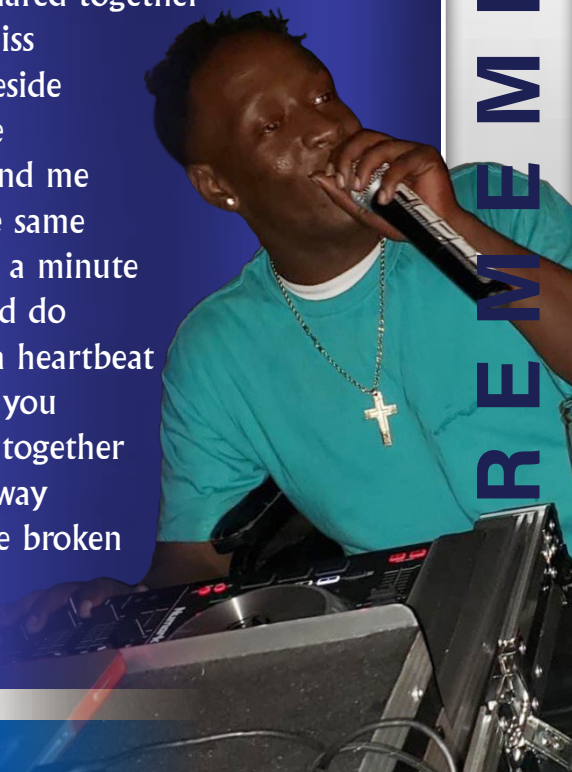
It broke my heart to lose you,

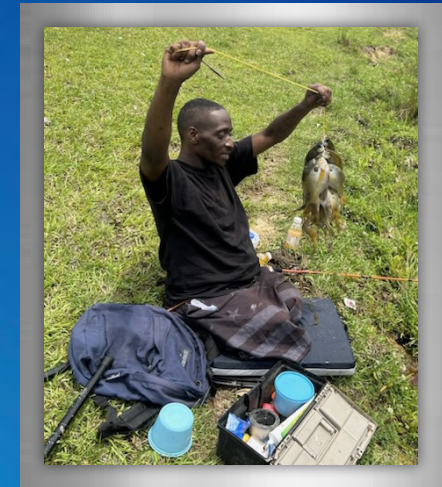
A CELEBRATED LIFE

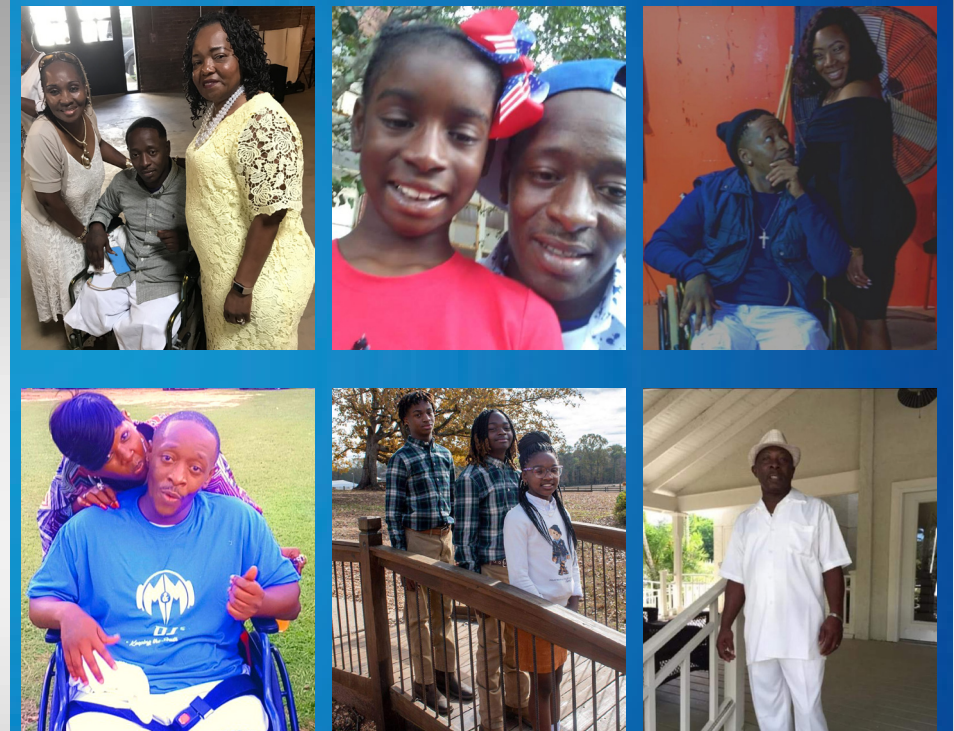
