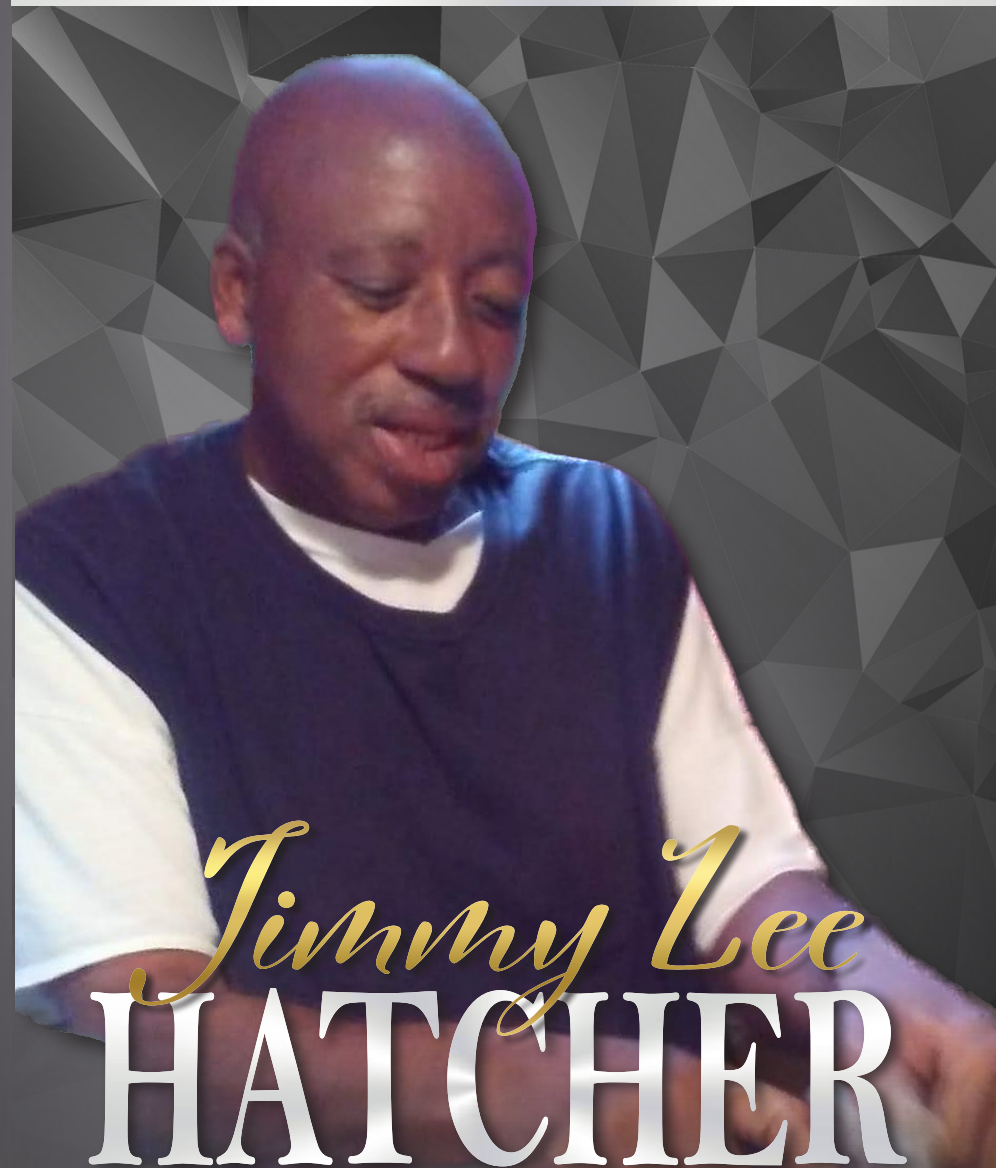

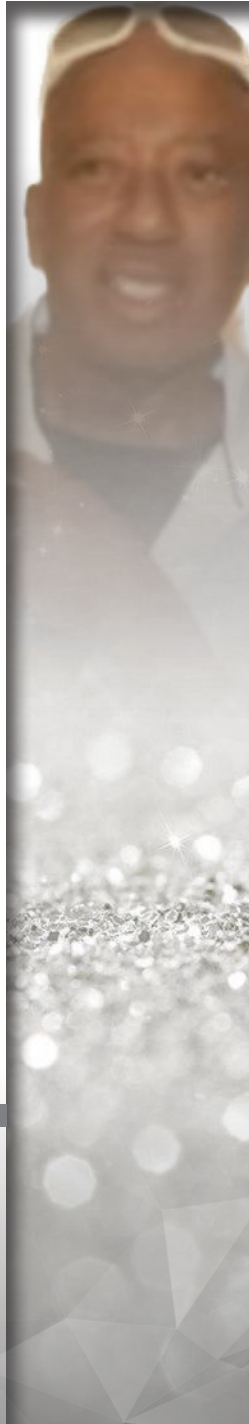
He is preceded in death by his mother, Mattie V. Hatcher and father, Dive Baskin.
