

Rev. Louis Edward Pugh was born September 22, 1937 in Union Springs, AL to Ezell Pugh White. Rev. Pugh was raised by his grandparents, Aaron and Margie Pugh.

Rev. L. E. Pugh accepted the Lord at an early age where he served at the Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church. He attended Lee Elementary Community School in Union Springs, AL and relocated to Akron, OH where he graduated from South High School in June 1958.

He then relocated to Chicago, IL where he held various jobs. He accepted his call to the ministry while serving the community in transportation getting the citizens safely to their destinations. Once he accepted the call he taught them the word of God letting them know how to reach their eternal destination---heaven.

Rev. L. E. Pugh relocated back to Union Springs in 2001 after hearing the voice of the Lord telling him to return.

He united in holy matrimony to Mozell Allen Pugh who preceded him in death.

Rev. L. E. Pugh served his community as City Councilman in two separate terms and also as Sergeant Deputy with the Bullock County Sheriff's Department in Union Springs, AL. He served as Pastor of Hawkins Chapel Missionary Baptist Church in Inverness, AL and as Associate Pastor of Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church in Union Springs. He regularly served at the Union Springs nutrition Center and the Southern Springs Nursing Home in Union Springs, AL teaching the word of God. Rev. L. E. Pugh was preceded in death by his mother and stepfather, Ezell and John White, his grandparents, Aaron and Margie Pugh; his brother, Madison Pugh, Sr.; his son, Timothy Pugh; and his grandson, Joshua Pugh.

Rev. L. E Pugh fought a good fight; he kept the faith and finished his course on Monday, November 20, 2023.
