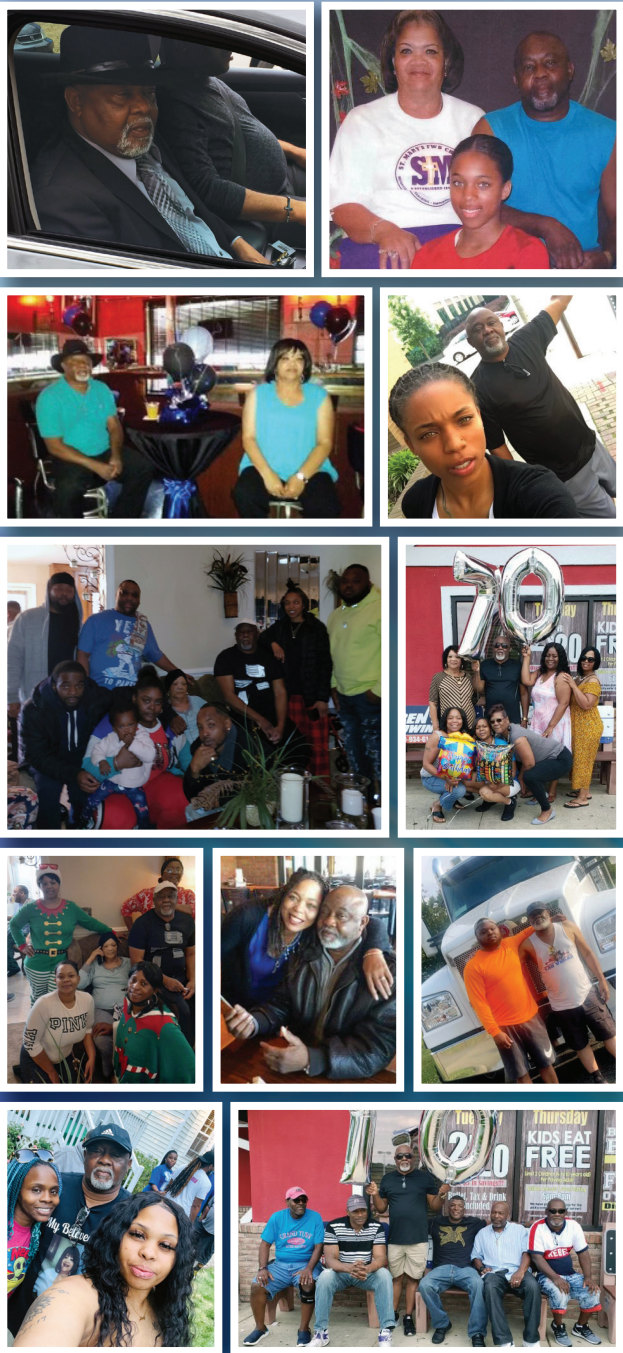
ORDER OF SERVICE
