and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever.



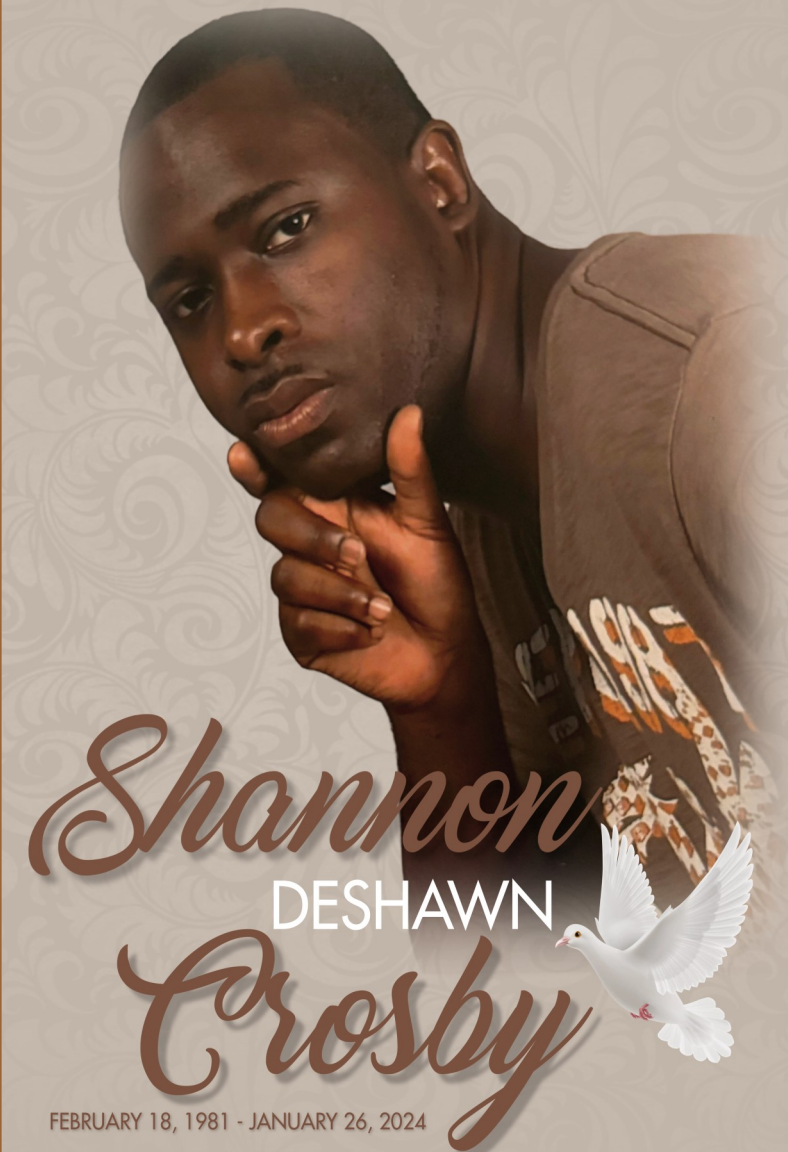
