Who cannot wait to greet me and to whisper "Welcome Home".

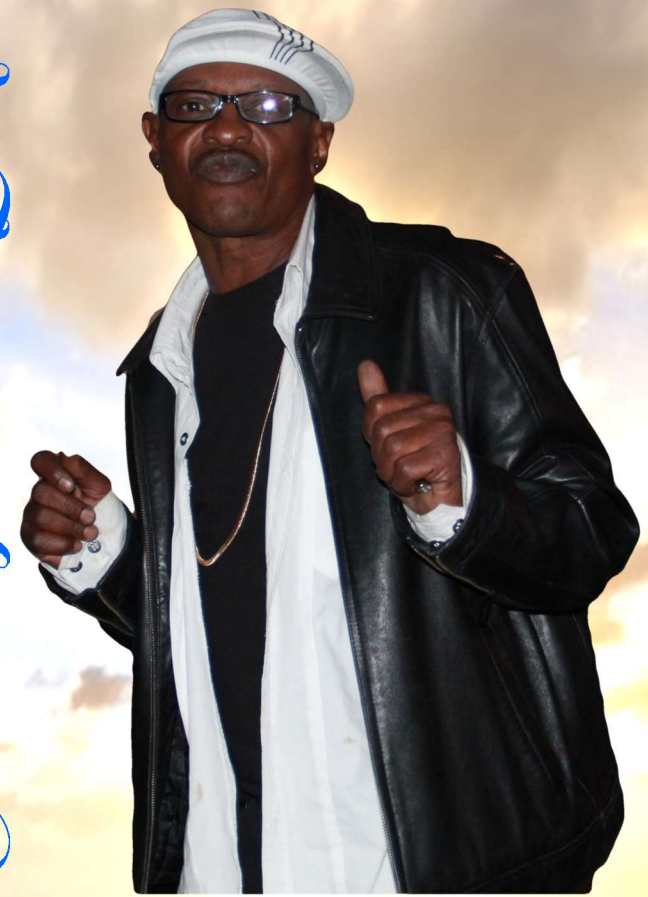
