Obituary

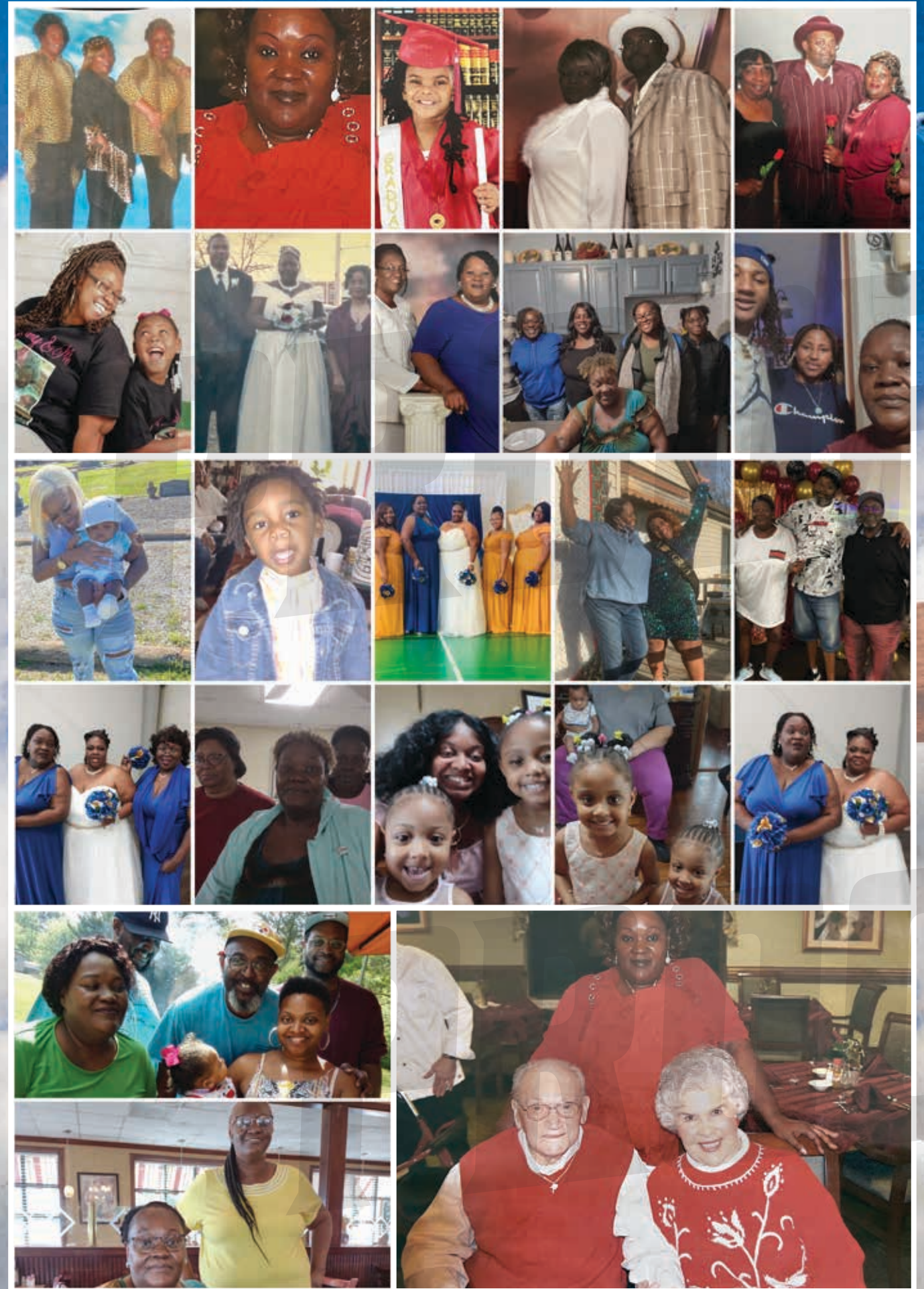
Mrs. Sylvia Ann Pulley-Pyles, age 56, departed this on June 29, 2023, at her home.
