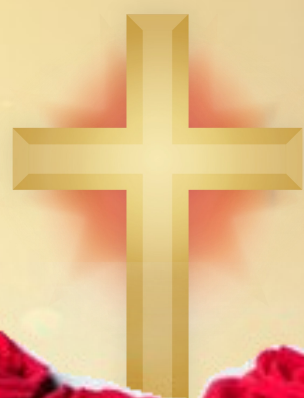
AFTERGLOW
