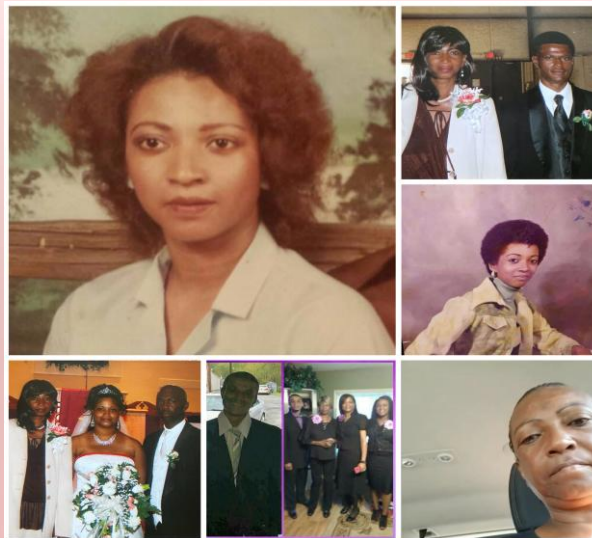
MEMORIES OF ROBIN
