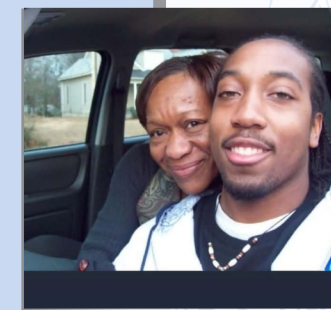
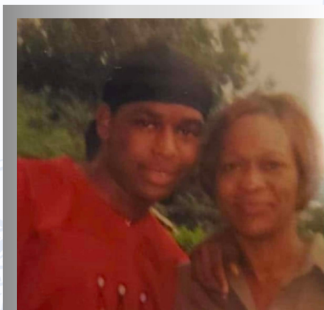
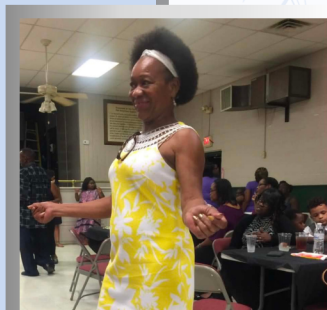
Audtrice was preceded in death by her siblings, Shirley Allen, Curtis Allen, Helen Ruth Allen, and Johnnie B. Allen.
