After years of showcasing a deep passion for entertaining and informing, Patrice transferred her gift to CBS Radio B106.3 and X102.3, where she concluded her nearly 30-year career in radio. Known for her wit, charm, and unparalleled ability to connect with listeners, she left an unforgettable mark on the world of broadcasting. Her career presented opportunities for her to interview big names in Hip-Hop and R&B music such as Fat Joe, Faith Evans, Trey Songs and Amerie, to name a few. She also had the pleasure of meeting famous comedians like: Monique, Sommore, John Witherspoon, Lavell Crawford, Michael Blackson and many more. Her voice reached thousands of listeners across the airways for almost 30 years. As we mourn the loss of this beloved figure, we remember the joy she brought to countless lives and the lasting impact she had on the realm of radio.

Patrice, the esteemed radio personality, is survived by her devoted family and fondly remembered by friends. Among them is Tammie Simmons, a cherished companion for over 25 years. Together, they welcomed their beautiful daughter, Kennedy Simmons-Wright in September 2008. As a parent to Kennedy, Patrice imparted not only her boundless love but also a legacy of warmth, laughter, and unwavering support. Her influence extends beyond the airwaves, leaving an enduring imprint on Kennedy, who will forever cherish the memories and values passed down by her beloved Mom.
