

# Obituary

As a brother, he was a fierce protector who watched over his siblings, older and younger. He was a constant presence in the lives of his siblings and rarely missed moments to gather with the family. Earl was an honorable man of God who loved and committed his life to his wife, Jade. He gave his life to the Lord and was baptized at Hope New Testament Church of God one month before his passing. He was preceded in death by his wonderful mother, Nellie Anglin, who we know has already welcomed her son home with the warmest embrace.
