# OBITUARY

Jumoke Kayode Young was born in Brooklyn, New York on August 13, 1990. From an early age, he showed a deep love for music, the arts, and basketball. Alongside his elementary school education, he studied drums for several years at the Ifetayo Performance School, where his creativity and passion began to shine.

At the age of 10, Jumoke and his family relocated to Georgia before settling in Florida a few months later. Shortly after arriving, he became an active member of Ascension Peace Presbyterian Church, where he formed lasting friendships and found a strong sense of community. He was deeply involved in church life, becoming a choir member and participating in plays, talent shows, and musicals.

His connection to the church remained strong throughout middle school and into his high school years at Coral Glades High School, where he joined chorus under Mr. Luffered and sang in many state and district competitions.

Music was at the heart of who Jumoke was. He loved creating music with friends, through his high school choir, with church friends, writing songs, and performing alongside others who shared his passion. His talent was celebrated when he was chosen as the male soloist at his high school graduation.

In addition to music, Jumoke loved basketball and proudly played on his high school basketball team until his senior year, when a torn meniscus ended his season.

Jumoke graduated from Coral Glades High School in 2008 and went on to study music at Bethune-Cookman College in Daytona Beach, Florida. After encountering challenges that required time away, he later returned to school and completed his Associate's degree in Music at Broward College in 2014.

On Sunday, January 18, 2026, the Lord called Jumoke home. Though his earthly journey has come to an end, he will forever be remembered for his creativity, kindness, gentle spirit, and the deep love he had for music and for those around him. Jumoke loved people simply as human beings and never judged others, regardless of color, religion, status, or circumstance. His presence touched many lives, and his memory will continue to live on through the songs he sang, the music he created, and the hearts of all who knew and loved him.

Jumoke leaves to cherish his memory his siblings: Richard, Tiron, Nadir, Dia, Ariel, Shakir, and Akin; and his sisters Jamila, Akila, Shanaz, Isoke, Yetunde, Adenike, and Ajibike, along with a host of nieces and nephews, cousins, aunts, uncles, extended family members, and dear friends.

He now joins in eternal rest his father, Steadman Young, and his brother, Sadiki Young. Jumoke is lovingly remembered by his devoted mother, Denise Young.
