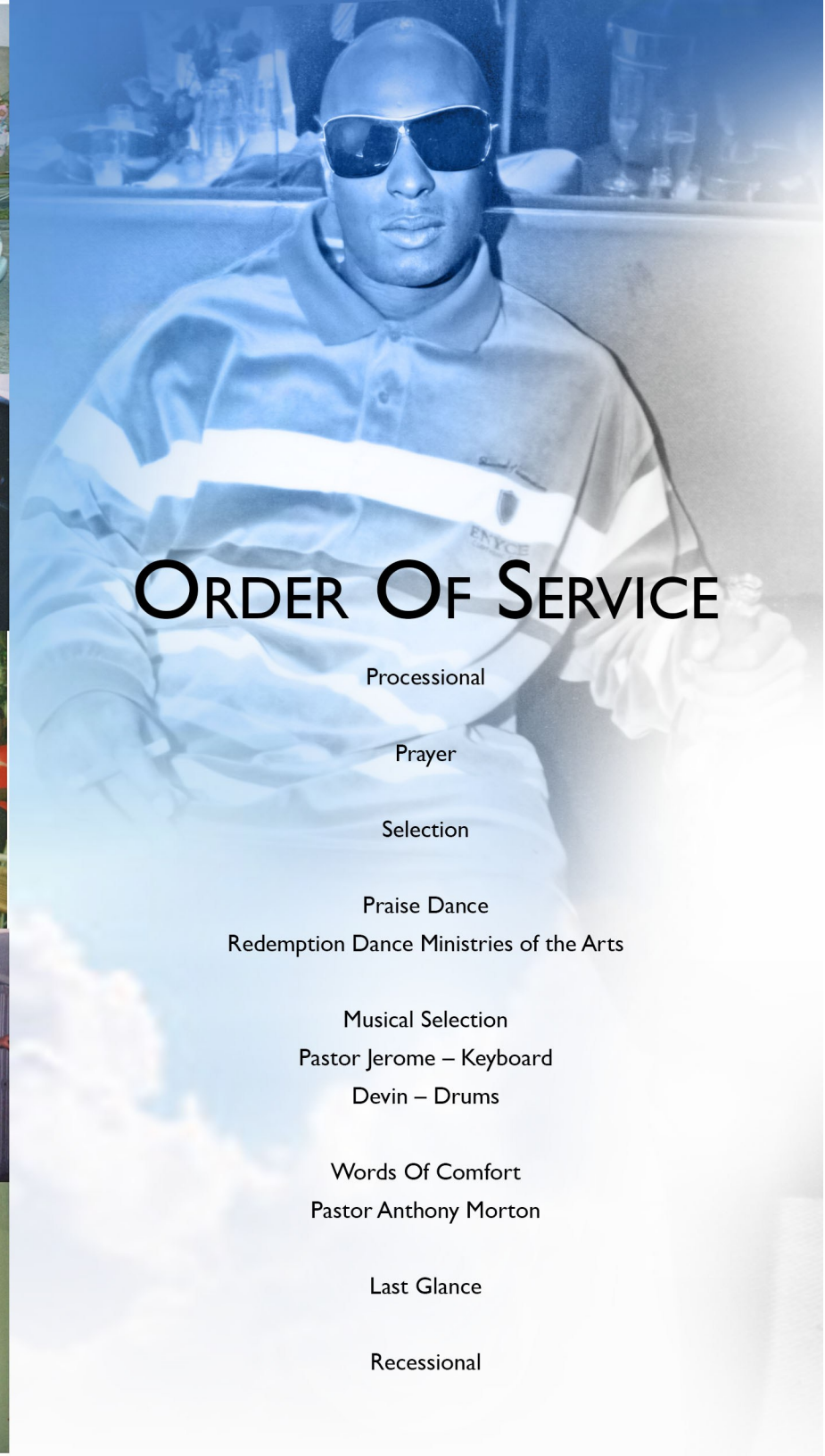
HIS STORY
