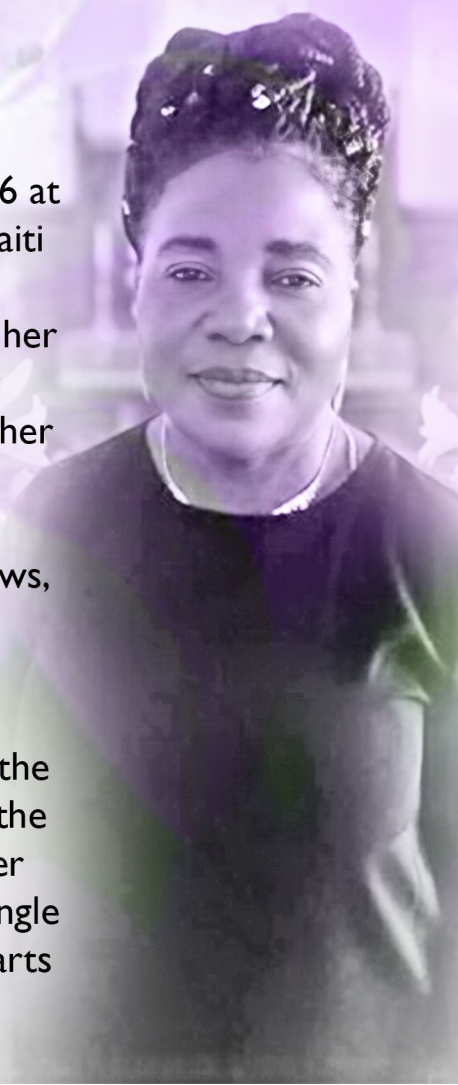
Her Story
