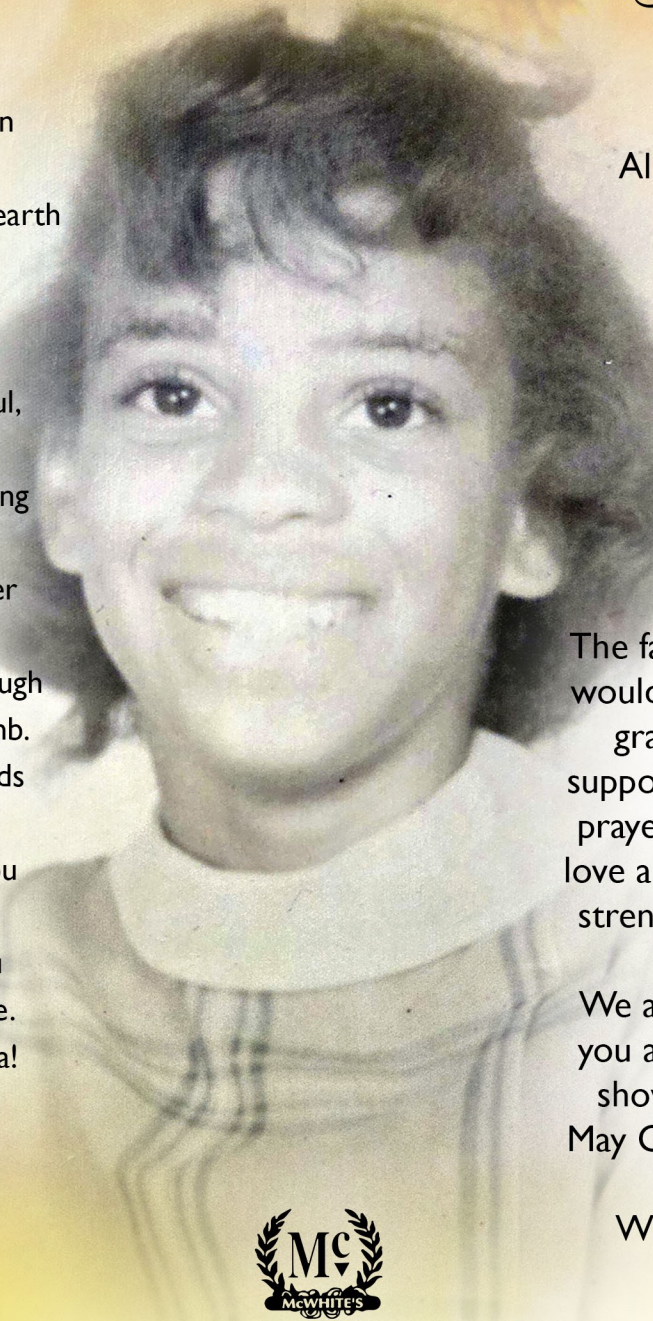


*God's Gardens*
