# Reflections of Life

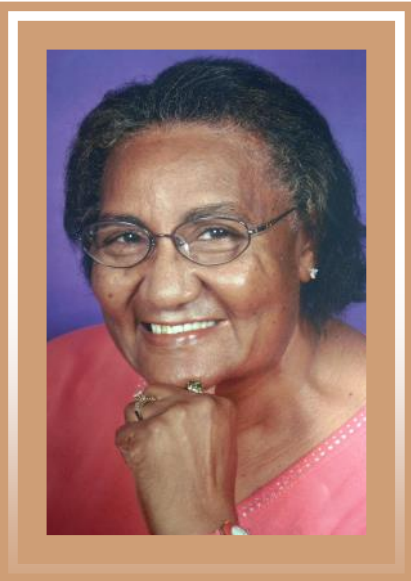
Mrs. Katherine Elizabeth Shoemaker Stevenson
