Mrs. Mary Beatrice Scales Salters A Virtuous Woman

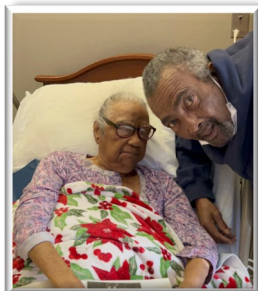
