all my love around you soft and clear.*

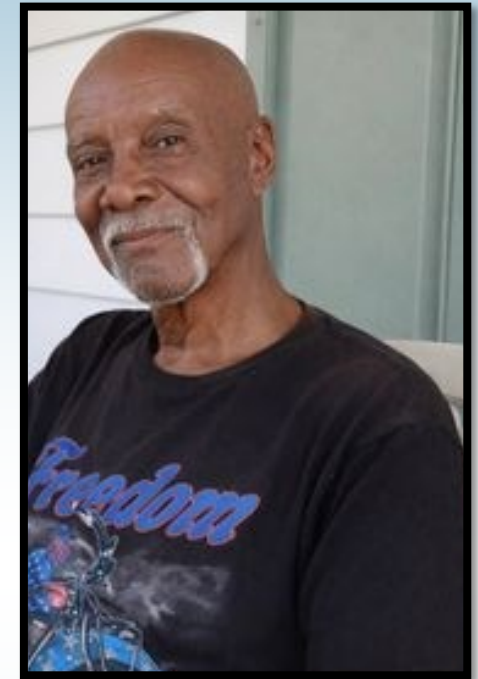
