Right beside the crystal sea

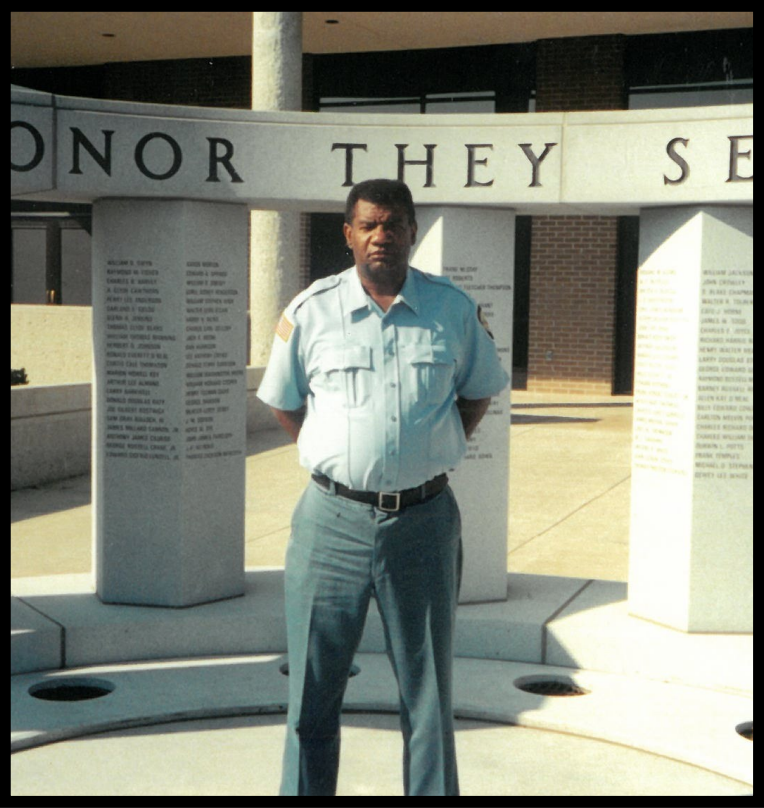
If you knew where my mansion's
