He will truly be missed by his family and community. From the smile, hugs and just the genuine love he showed to everyone he met.

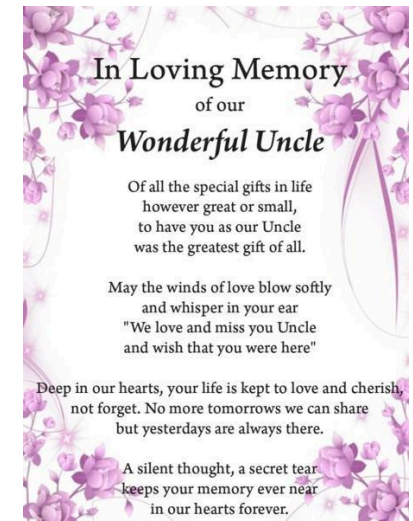
TRIBUTES
